#### Perspective on Mechanical Root Cutting

I read Peter Kenter's article, Routing Roots (Tech Perspective, Cleaner, December 2008) with great interest, and I found that I agreed with many of the comments made by David Bradford of Shamrock Pipe Tools.

Our company, Productive Carbides Inc., is a carbide fabricator and tool manufacturer. Our comments favor cutting tools and are based on feedback from contractors working in the trenches. We add carbide teeth and wear pads to the standard 6- through 18-inch flat or concave saws used to remove roots and calcium deposits.

Saws are one inch smaller in diameter than the pipes being cleaned. Our special teeth and wear pads add approximately 1/4 inch to the diameter, so there is still plenty of clearance. The carbide increases the life of the saws by eight to 10 times. Many contractors use the specialty carbide-tipped saws to cut taps flush with the walls of the mainline in preparation for lining.

Jets are great for debris removal, but require close control to cut through roots. It can be done; high-pressure water is used to cut steel and other metals in metal shops that can position the jets precisely. We have furnished carbide nozzles with precision holes for close pressure control during cleaning, but the idea did not catch on in the field (probably too time-consuming).

We have braised carbide to chain for added life in flail chain cleaning. Many municipalities will not permit chain cleaning, as it destroys the line if conditions are not perfect. If a sewer line is broken open, an expensive excavation is usually required for repair. A few minutes with a carbide-tipped saw reduces the fracture risk.

Waterjet nozzles, steel saw cutters and chain knockers are usually available to most contractors. The selection of which to use depends on the contractor's ability to see the root or obstruction, direct the cutter, and clear the area for inspection and recutting if necessary. Jet nozzles take the most control to direct the jet squarely onto the root. Saw cutters take less control, but even they are often moved back and forth over a joint to get it clean. The chain flail will pulverize the roots, but will possibly take out parts of the pipe if not watched closely.

The choice of the best tool, knowing one's limitations, and the skill of the operator determine the profit from a cleaning job. Most contractors will talk about problem jobs, but are closed-mouthed about the jobs they successfully complete. Trade secrets and lack of good information cloud discussions on what really works best.

# Know Your Enemy

It's always worth revisiting the dangers of hydrogen sulfide, the highly toxic gas most often associated with sewer fatalities

very year, some sewer workers, farmers, construction workers and others die from exposure to hydrogen sulfide (H<sub>2</sub>S).

Why should this be? The hazards are well known. A whole industry has grown up around protecting people about this and other toxic gases. There's confined-



space entry training. There are confined-space safety systems that include gas detectors, tripods with winches, respirators and other gear.

Why should anyone ever be exposed to harmful amounts of this gas? Well, it's because either they don't know the risks or they ignore the warnings. So it's worthwhile to revisit the dangers of H<sub>2</sub>S, and especially to share the information with new people coming into the drain and pipe maintenance profession.

#### Know the basics

OSHA provides extensive information about H<sub>2</sub>S. Here are some facts and cautionary advice taken from an H<sub>2</sub>S fact sheet.

H<sub>2</sub>S is a colorless, flammable, extremely hazardous gas that has a rotten egg smell. It is sometimes called sewer gas, stink damp, swamp gas, or manure gas. It comes from bacterial breakdown of materials like manure and sewage.

H<sub>2</sub>S is heavier than air and collects in low-lying, enclosed and poorly ventilated areas, including manholes and sewer lines. The primary route of exposure is inhalation; the lungs absorb the gas rapidly.

You can smell H<sub>2</sub>S at low concentrations, but after continuous nervous system. Its effects can vary depending how much you are exposed to and for how long. Low concentrations irritate the eyes, nose, throat and respiratory system you may experience burning or tearing of the eyes, coughing, or shortness of breath. People with asthma may have trouble breathing.

The effects can be delayed for several hours, or sometimes several days, when you work in low concentrations. Repeated or prolonged exposures may cause eye inflammation, headaches, fatigue, irritability,

any other necessary personal protective equipment, as well as rescue and communication equipment. The OSHA confined spaces standard contains specific requirements for identifying, monitoring and entering confined spaces.

OSHA has determined that a level of H<sub>2</sub>S gas at or above 100 parts per million is immediately dangerous to life and health (IDLH). Entry into IDLH atmospheres can only be made using a full-facepiece, pressure-demand, self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) with a

#### Effects on health

H<sub>2</sub>S is both an irritant and a chemical asphyxiant. It affects oxygen utilization and the central insomnia, digestive disturbances and weight loss. Moderate concentrations can cause more severe eye and respiratory irritation (coughing, difficulty breathing, fluid in the lungs), as well as headaches, dizziness, nausea, vomiting, staggering and excitability.

High concentrations can cause shock, convulsions, inability to breathe, extremely rapid unconsciousness, coma and death. Effects can occur within a few breaths and possibly a single breath.

#### Protecting yourself

Before you enter an area where H<sub>2</sub>S may be present, the air must be tested for its presence and concentration by a qualified person, using equipment such as H<sub>2</sub>S detector tubes or a multi-gas meter. Testing should also determine if fire or explosion precautions are also necessary. If the gas is present, the space must be ventilated continually.

If the gas cannot be removed, the person entering the space must use appropriate respiratory protection and

minimum service life of 30 minutes, or a combination full-facepiece, pressure-demand, supplied-air respirator with an auxiliary self-contained air supply.

If the H<sub>2</sub>S level is below 100 ppm, an air-purifying respirator may be used, assuming the filter cartridge/canister is appropriate for H<sub>2</sub>S. A full-facepiece respirator will prevent eye irritation.

If air concentrations are elevated, eye irritation may become a serious issue. If a half-mask respirator is used, tight-fitting goggles must also be used. Workers in areas containing H<sub>2</sub>S must be monitored for signs of overexposure.

And finally, OSHA warns that no one should attempt a rescue in an area that may contain H<sub>2</sub>S without using appropriate respiratory protection and without being trained in such rescues. The likely result of attempting a rescue while untrained and ill-equipped is a multiple fatality.

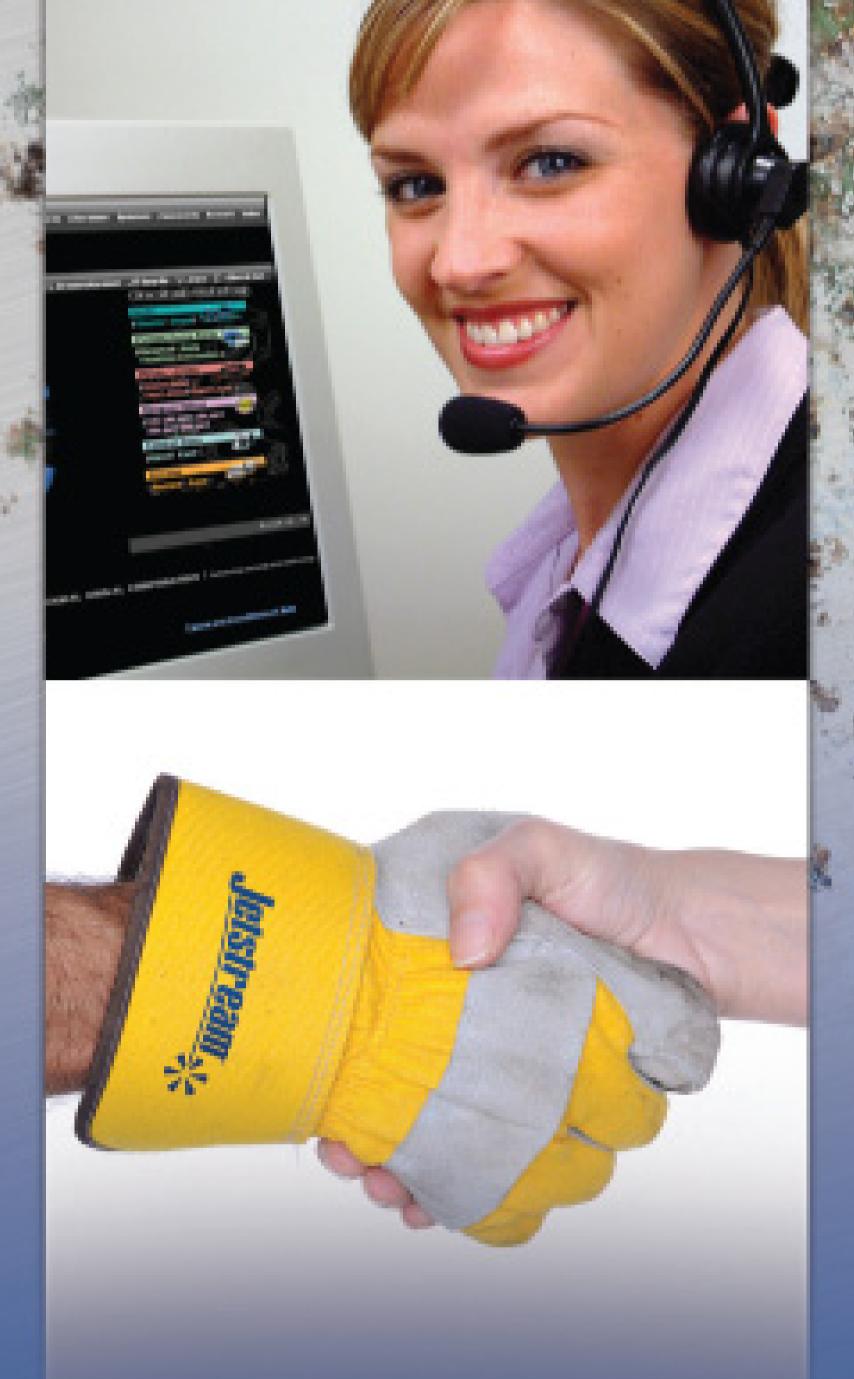

### 46 Ways to Pay Taxes

An understanding of individual state laws, good records and a big supply of antacid tablets can help you survive a sales tax audit

n 1930, Mississippi became the first state to adopt a general sales tax. Since then, all but four states have jumped on the bandwagon, and 46 states means 46 sets of rules, regulations, rates and exemptions.

For many years, sales tax laws in other states weren't of much concern to small businesses. It was mostly big companies that engaged in interstate commerce. But now the world is one big shopping mall, and with a few keystrokes consumers can buy goods in any state from Maine to California.

In a 1992 decision, the U.S Supreme Court exempted out-of-state retailers from collecting sales taxes in states where they have no physical

Connecticut, but are taxable once you cross into Massachusetts. It doesn't take much research to see that learning all the differences in sales tax laws would require more antacids than both those states could hold.

#### If you're audited

The best defense in a sales/use tax audit is thorough record keeping. Detailed documentation could save you big money in taxes and penalties, while decreasing the amount you have to spend on defending yourself in the audit.

Some records that may be reviewed include sales tax returns, worksheets, canceled checks, federal income tax returns, state tax returns,

only what they ask for. Too much information can potentially uncover liabilities they weren't even looking for and waste a lot of your time. Too little information might raise the auditor's suspicions and cause the scope of the audit to be increased.

While sales tax and use-tax regulations vary slightly for retailers, laws vary wildly for construction, manufacturing, distribution and other businesses like drain cleaning that may have mixed taxable and nontaxable transactions. To help you understand where you may have sales tax exposure and get a jump on a possible audit, learn the laws of your state and the states where you have a physical presence.

Most states detail their rules on the Internet.

The best defense in a sales/use tax audit is thorough record keeping.

Detailed documentation could save you big money in taxes and penalties, while decreasing the amount you have to spend on defending yourself in the audit.

Although that decision involved a mail order company, the ruling has been applied to all remote sellers, including online retailers. The result? Companies have increased their geographic market, costing states billions in sales tax revenue.

#### The use tax

So, what are states doing? Many are trying to strengthen use-tax compliance. A use tax applies to transactions not subject to sales tax where tangible personal property, bought in one state, is used in another state. The use tax is generally the same rate as the state's sales tax, and is to be paid by the party making the purchase. That means you may owe use tax on a computer you ordered from another state and on which you did not pay sales tax.

Use tax looks like sales tax, smells like sales tax and costs like sales tax, so states are making up for sales tax losses and enforcing the collection of use tax by conducting sales/use tax audits. All this means you need to be prepared. There has been a noticeable increase in sales/use tax audits as states try to recoup those lost sales tax revenues.

Tax laws vary greatly from state to state. Here is just one quirky example: Antacids are exempt in

general ledger, general journal and closing entries, sales invoices, exemption documents supporting nontaxable sales, charts of accounts, fixed asset purchases/sales invoices, expense purchases, merchandise purchases, bank statements, canceled checks and deposit slips, cash receipts and depreciation schedules.

A sales/use tax audit usually begins when an auditor contacts you by letter or phone to schedule a pre-audit meeting. In this meeting, the auditor will typically present an audit authorization letter and other documents for you to sign. He or she will then explain what records are required to complete the audit and ask for additional information such as details of

To prepare for the scheduled audit, you will need to gather and organize the records requested by the auditor. Don't provide too much or too little information –

#### The Contractor's Wife

It is often the bookkeeping spouse who has the best perspective on what ails a business, and often on what it takes to set things right

'd like to share with you a letter I once received from a contractor's wife. The letter basically speaks for itself.

"Ten years ago my husband's partner died. As no one else came running forward, I picked up his job managing the books. How hard could it be?

"After years of struggling, we joined the Plumbing-Heating-Cooling Contractors Association. We went looking for kindred souls. Surely there were folks out there who could help us figure out what we were doing wrong. We were working hard and getting nowhere, but we were doing, it seemed, what every other contractor was doing. Why were we going broke? What were we missing?

"At the convention I asked lots of questions. 'How are things in your business? Are you making money? How many hours a week do you work?' The men huffed, 'Busy as hell. Things couldn't be better.' But I noticed behind each pompous fellow, a woman with a slightly wrinkled brow and bit of a frown. I started to figure out there was more to the story.

"Women in this industry often take on the role of bookkeeper. The plumbers are too busy doing the 'important' stuff, like turning wrenches. They have neither the time nor ability to do things like bill paying, determining pricing strategies, laundry or dusting. So the woman, bless her heart, does the housekeeping and the bookkeeping. One of two things happens at this point.

"Scenario 1: Mrs. Herman's job consists of sweeping up after Mr. Herman. Her husband can't be bothered to talk to customers to get approval before he starts working. He goes at it, turns wrenches and tells her to bill Mr. Fernwicky. She

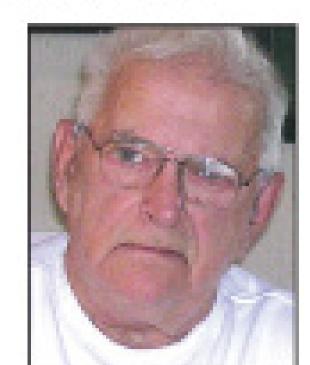
does. Mr. Fernwicky calls and accuses her of highway robbery. She apologizes.

"Mr. and Mrs. Herman argue. She tells him to work harder. They need the money. He tells her she is a spendthrift. She shouldn't be wasting money on those business seminars. She gets a second job to make ends meet. Every once in awhile they attend a PHCC function. They dress up and pretend they are wealthy and successful – like all the other plumbing contractors.

"Scenario 2: Mrs. Progressive acknowledges what she's learning - that most contractors don't know how to run a business, and to blindly follow their lead is foolish. She reads the financial data she collects and realizes that their selling prices must

charging enough to cover the costs of doing business'), they can become a powerful force in bettering our industry. Surely we care about these guys and understand their worth. By realizing our own capabilities, we can work together to create family businesses worth passing on to our children. It's time to accept our own responsibilities in this industry."

There are many husband and wife teams in the contracting fields working long hours side by side, often for substandard pay and benefits. One of my pet peeves is that not only do most contractors fail to compensate themselves fairly, more often than not, they pay their working wives nothing at all! This is a form of modern-day slavery, yet

go up. Drawing on her experience as a consumer, she understands the need to improve their customer service and selling systems.

"She meets with Mr. Progressive. They argue. But they both commit to improving the business. They determine that the reward for their hard work should be commensurate with the risk and hassle. They objectively view their strengths and weaknesses. They refine and delegate job positions, respecting each other's areas of expertise. They develop a company they can be proud of.

"Though there are days I wish I didn't work

with my husband, I feel my place is in the business. When I took on the accounting duties, I had no idea how incapable I was. But over time, by keeping an open mind and learning changing, I've become a businesswoman.

"If other wives out there will validate what they know is

it's the only way they can make ends meet with the typical prices charged for work.

This woman was astute enough to pinpoint that root cause of under-pricing. She also deserves applause for taking action to correct the problem. Her point is well taken: Frequently it is the bookkeeping spouse who has the best perspective on what ails the business. The hard part then becomes pounding this message through the thick skull of a husband who thinks first, last and always like a laborer rather than a businessman.

Habits are hard to break - such as not being able to pay bills on time, not being able to provide for a family, or not putting money aside for retirement. I applaud spouses who dive in to help out in a family business and try to break some of those old habits.

Developing a business requires a great deal of commitment and hours. It requires paying attention to numbers, developing strategies, and attending trade functions after business hours. As a business owner or manager, you will encounter worries that may be too burdensome for one mind.

Share with your mate fears about finances, thoughts about problem customers and employees, or that new advertising campaign. Developing ('Honey, we are not support on the home front can be reassuring.





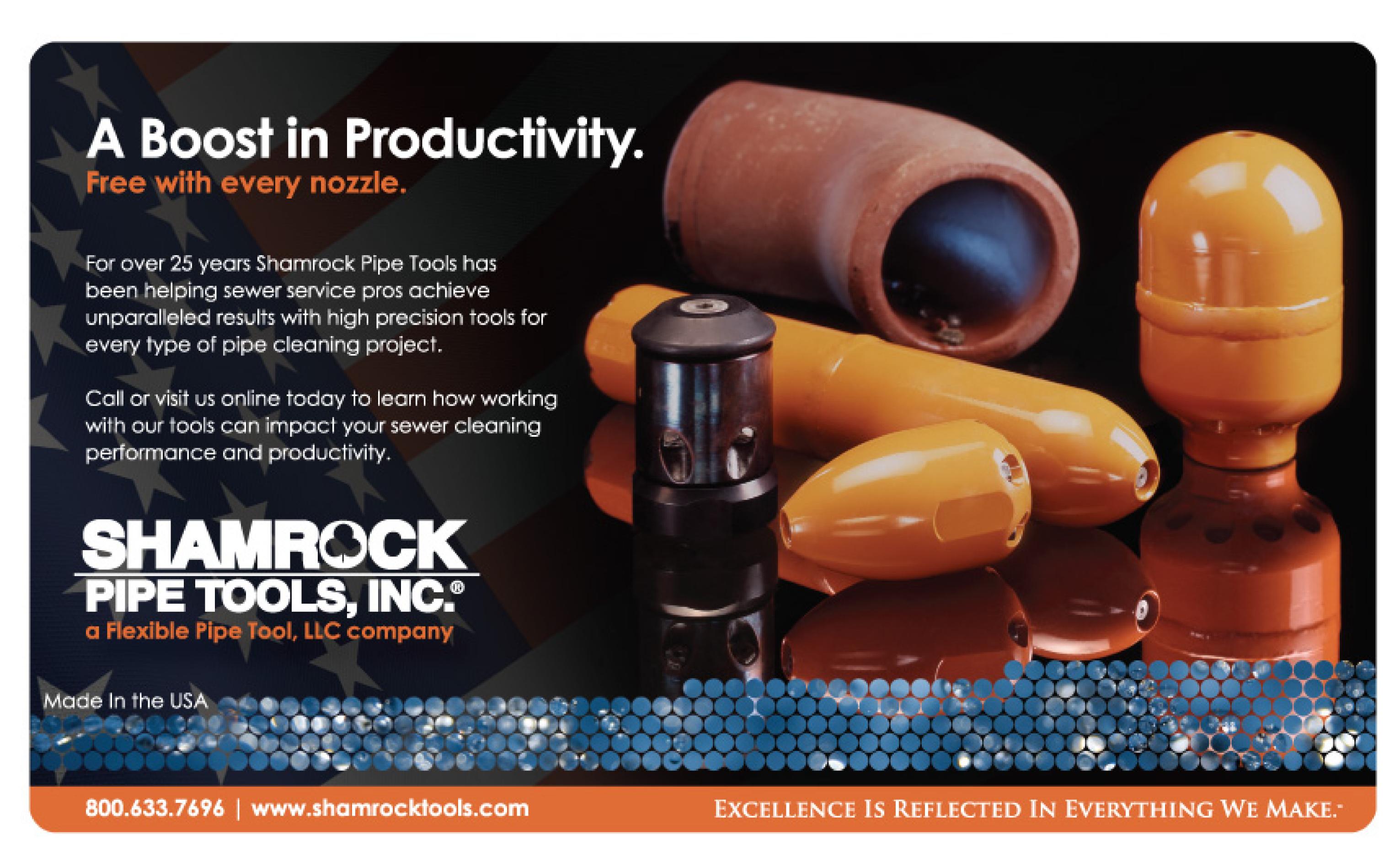

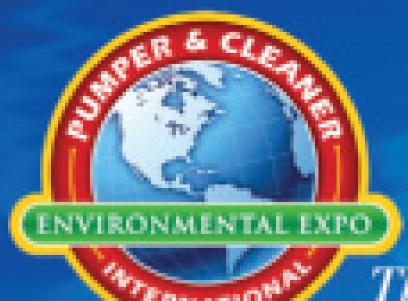

## Milwaukee-area drain cleaner's trucks are integrated with inventory software to keep field technicians organized and well stocked

Berlin, Wis., uses plumbing and drain-cleaning service trucks that work seamlessly with sophisticated inventory software.

It all starts inside the company's 12 Hino and Isuzu/Chevrolet trucks, outfitted with 12-foot aluminum bodies made by HI-V-CO (one body was made by Hackney USA). Each truck has the same

custom-made HI-V-CO storage system, composed of aluminum shelves and 80 plastic bins (40 on each side wall).

#### Highly systematic

Each bin is assigned a number, as is each slot inside the bin. The slots also carry a quantity number and a brief description of the part stored. Part numbers correspond with the specific bin and slot in which they should be stored; the

numbers start with either an L or an R to tell the technicians on which side of the truck the part is stored.

"So, for example, part number L1206 goes on the left side of the truck, bin 12, slot 6," says general manager A.J. Jonathan. When technicians submit invoices, they also fill out a restocking slip that tells parts stockers how many of the parts were used, the

part descriptions, and the part numbers. All parts are restocked in no more than 48 hours.

The aisles in the parts department are laid out exactly like the insides of the trucks, making it easy for part stockers to find parts. The company manages its parts inventory with software made by Maio Success Systems Inc.

The idea for the numbering/restocking system came from an industry seminar. "It helps because most of the time, the guys are driving fully stocked trucks," Jonathan says. "If they need a fitting, for example, they don't have to make a supply house run. That saves us hundreds of dollars a day in lost production and wages.

#### Lots of space

Parts manager John Oberhofer observes, "The trucks are like miniature hardware stores. They save each technician a couple of hours a day, especially if you consider that when they go to a supply house, they could easily sit for 20 minutes before they even get waited on. Over a year, they unbelievable amounts of time and money."

Flat Rate also found the inviting trucks because they carry more

inventory than the previous trucks. Each truck can hold a 90-gallon water heater, tools, drain-cleaning equipment (RIDGID K-1500 and K-50 sectional drain cleaners), two toilets, and 10-foot lengths of various kinds of pipe. The trucks also have a rear pullout ramp, 6 1/2-foot-high ceilings, and skylights. On the exterior, the trucks trumpet the company's name and phone number in red and blue on a white background.

Where would Flat Rate be without these trucks and the restocking system? "We'd be very disorganized," Jonathan says.

# Ready for Duty

Optimism pervades the exhibit hall as Pumper & Cleaner Expo attendees discover the latest technologies for pipe and drain cleaning, repair and maintenance

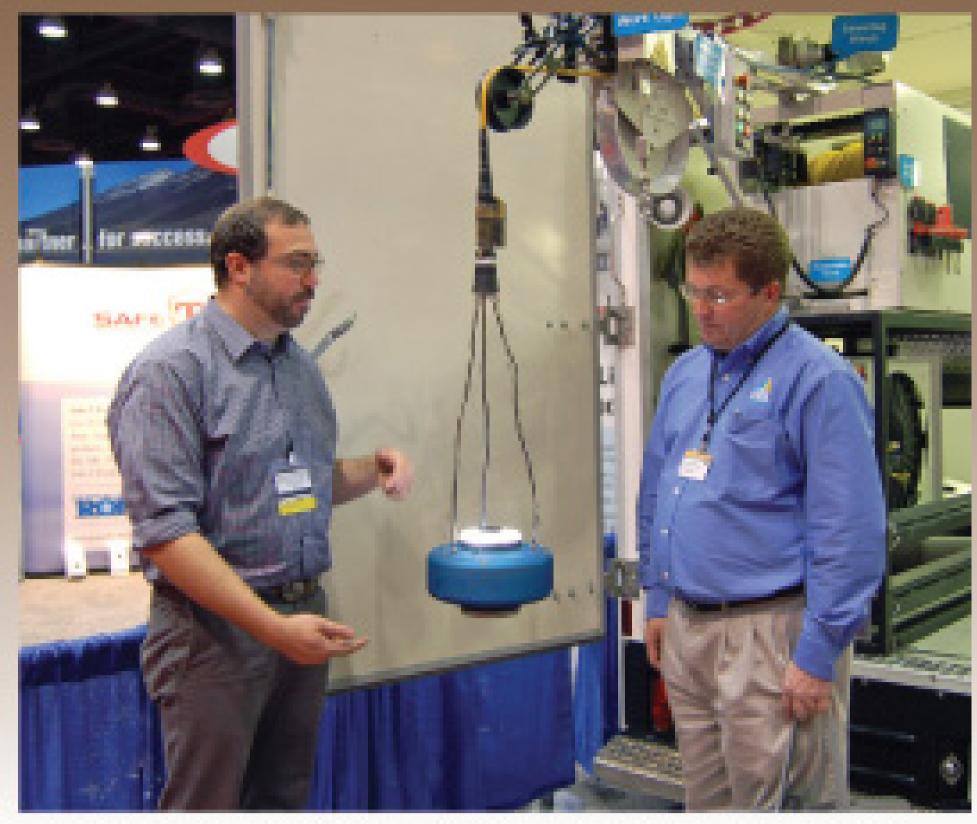

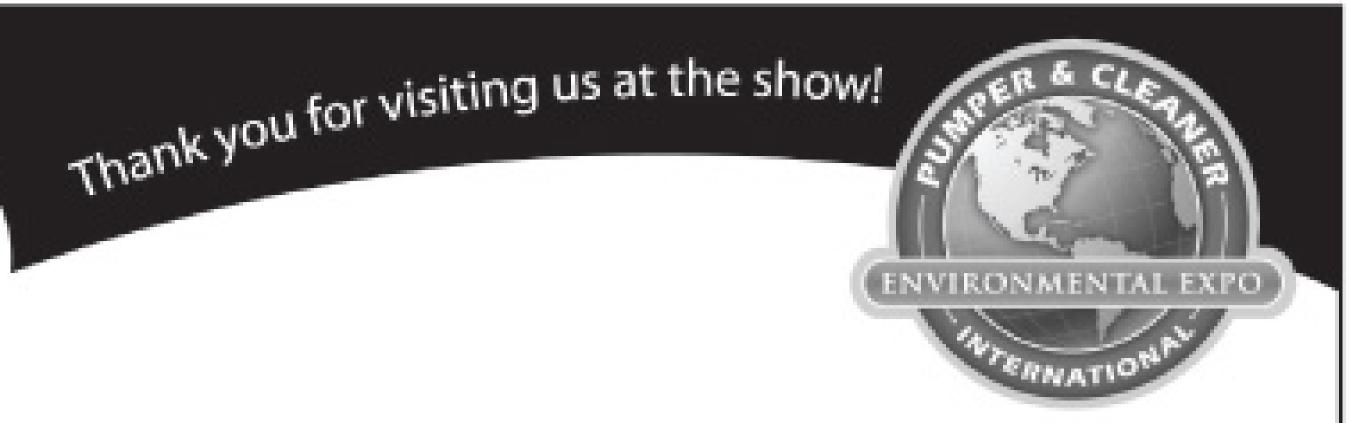

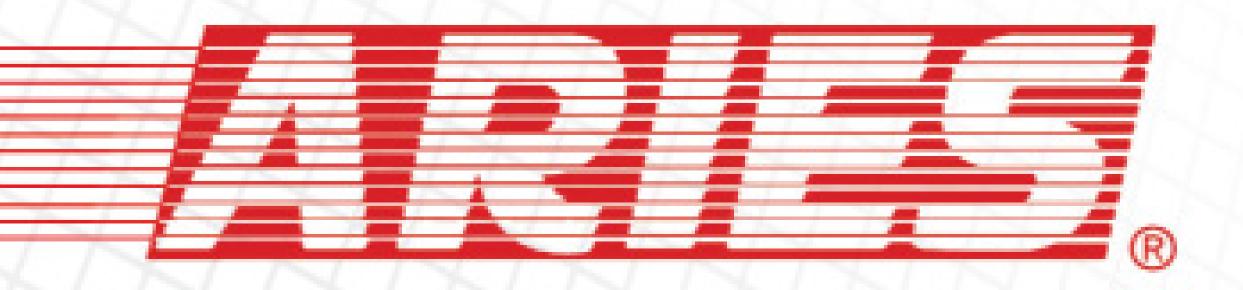

A South Carolina franchise uses video inspection and utility locating to drive growth in repairs and establish a strong business

By Marian Bond

Early in his time as owner of Rooter-Man in Charleston, S.C., Nelson Huggins offered video services to plumbing contractors at a discount. It gave an immediate boost to the bottom line, but Huggins found there was a disconnect. Too often, once customers had a line cleared, they did not see the value in using the camera.

"If everything was flushing, they would say no," Huggins says. "It was with the repeat problems where we would use the camera." After about a year in business, he decided to inspect every line and include the cost in the package price. That policy eliminated the callbacks and also increased sales.

"We found that by always using the camera, we could identify problems from broken pipes to bad joints to lines that needed replacement," Huggins says. "We now inform the customer of the repairs needed. The customer gets peace of mind. When the problem is on the monitor, the customer sees it and says, 'Let's get it fixed.' We make more money in the end."

Huggins started the business in 2006 with one van, which he drove. The plan was to do emergency service for commercial and residential customers. "That was our niche," he says. "To give our customers service – to have it done today. It has served us well."

Within eight weeks, he had hired a service technician and had generated enough calls to buy a second van. In just 24 months, he had grown the company to a fleet of six trucks and five full-time employees.

#### Starting small

Cameras have been a big part of the business from the beginning. Huggins got into the field after 17 years as a high school teacher and football coach. When he suddenly Rooter-Man franchise.

He opened his shop in 2006 with one new Ford E-250 van and a recommended package of equipment, mostly from General Pipe Cleaners, and including a Gen-Eye

faced high medical costs for a family member's illness, he had to make a career change. After searching for a stable, profitable business offering independence, he settled on a Junior camera. As the company grew, the cost of a camera for every van was a concern – but it was also a necessity.

"I knew I needed the cameras,"

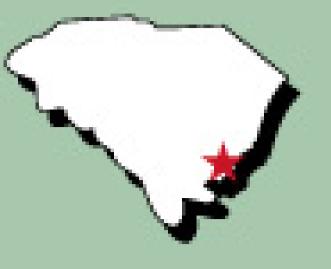

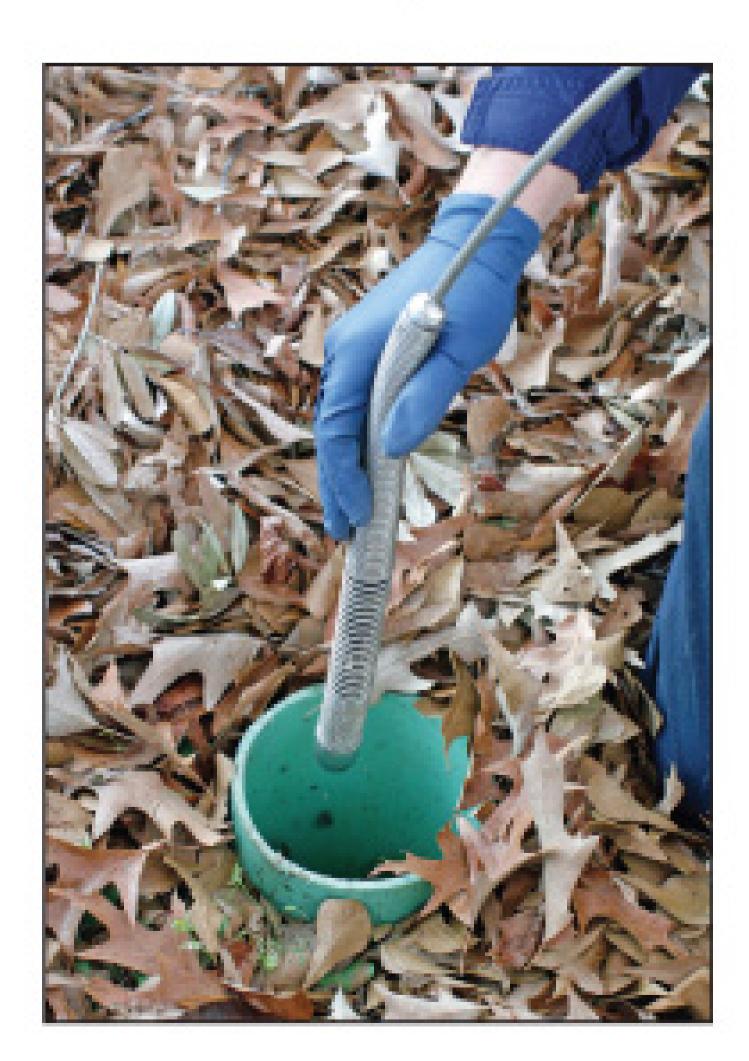


Huggins says. "One camera would not take care of all the jobs. We needed a camera on each truck." Huggins ultimately chose three cameras from South Coast Equipment, two from Bill's Video of Fargo, N.D., and one from Rothenberger USA.

All are push cameras, used in laterals from 30 to 100 feet long, typically 3- and 4-inch lines. The Gen-Eye and the Rothenberger go out on specialty jobs where technicians need a record of the inspection and an included locator. Huggins often operates these cameras himself or has a designated technician do so. "I don't want these valuable items on the truck on a regular basis," he says.

#### More the better

While locating was not a high priority at first, Huggins quickly saw it as another compatible service. He purchased equipment, an LF2000 model from Prototek, offering the service to customers and at a discount to plumbers. He has just the one locator, which goes out once or

twice per week on request, such as to find a sewer tap in an older neighborhood.

For jetting, Huggins uses a Hurricane 3010 trailer unit (3,000 psi/10 gpm) from Triple R Specialty. A cart-mounted unit, also from Triple R, handles smaller grease traps and restaurant lines. He also has a converted pressure washer (2,000 psi/4 gpm).

"Jetting is not something the consumer here is knowledgeable about," Huggins says. "We don't get a lot of requests for jetting. We find we have to explain the benefits. We put the camera down, find the problem, and fix the problem, but once that's done, if the line is open, that's basically what the customer wants.

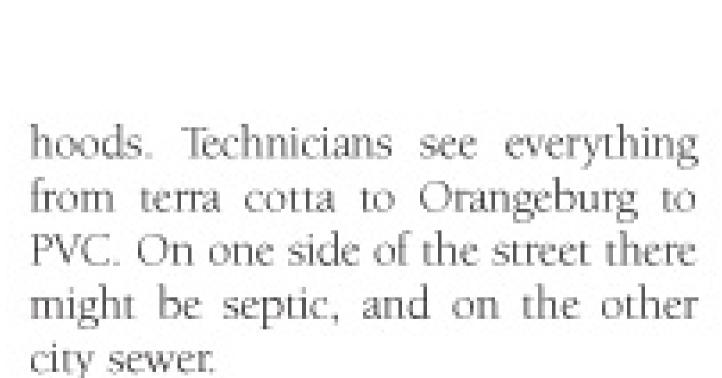
"We can show how the pipe is coated with grease or scale, and the only way it comes off is by jetting. However, they tend to be penny wise and pound foolish. I wish we were using the jetters more often. We have to work on that."

#### Branching out

As the fleet grew, Huggins needed a more suitable location. Within six months of opening his business, he rented office and warehouse space, where he has 2,500 square feet, plus parking. There is a garage area to house the jetters and one or two trucks. The trucks include a Ford E-250, four Ford E-150 vans, and a Ford F-150 pickup.

Huggins expanded by purchasing additional territories. He also opted to be licensed and to offer a full slate of plumbing services. "Our goal is to service everything all the way up the coast, to build the business from Georgia to North Carolina along Interstate 95," he says. "After two years, we're on track."

Covering such a large and diverse area means a variety of sewer systems in older and new neighbor-



camera from General Pipe Cleaners.

In growing the business according to plan, Huggins tracks the number of incoming calls every week. Staff members track requests and record any reasons the firm doesn't get the job. While all dispatching comes out of Charleston, the concept is to keep overhead down and expand by having technicians in the new locations.

Huggins finds the employees and supplies the van and all basic equipment. The technicians take everything home at the end of the work day. That's the paradigm Huggins will follow as he grows the business.

"It was a roll of the dice." That's how Nelson Huggins describes looking for a business where he would do the work, get paid, and avoid the effects of a slow economy.

He decided to open a RooterMan business in part because he found strength in the franchise concept. He took the Rooter-Man training and also connected with other franchise owners, who allowed him to visit their businesses and work with them for a while as an observer and helper. He has stayed involved with those who helped him, and they still swap ideas.

"It's kind of a brotherhood,"
Huggins says. "A group of people you
can call and ask questions and
nobody is holding back."

#### Training for the coach

While Huggins wanted a business that would not depend on the economy, there have been impacts. One big one is the price of fuel, as he serves a 40-miles radius in each territory. "We debated, and at first we absorbed the cost," Huggins says. "But we decided to add a fuel

game plan. You have to be able to adjust. When plan A doesn't work, then you go to plan B."

Huggins definitely has a plan, and he is following it aggressively and in a carefully managed fashion. It's all about the team and executing the plan. It's about winning. You might say it's his plan A.

Huggins' past career brought attributes that have served him well. "You are serving the public, and you are dealing with all types of people on a day-to-day basis," he says. "Some are glad to see you, and some are not. It was a definite plus being in education and being able to communicate. Teaching others how to do it has been a plus in growing a business.

"In business you look at it as a team," Huggins says. "Everybody has a role, and everybody must contribute to the bottom line. We try to reward the guys according to what they produce. Also, as a coach, you sometimes have to call people in and say, 'This isn't going the way we want it to go to get the results we want.' The coaching part is being able to deal with people and come up with a game plan. Business is a

# **Choosing Your Locator**

Here are some tips for understanding utility locating technologies and selecting a unit to suit your everyday working conditions

By Matt Manning

ocating underground utilities is becoming more of a challenge as the vast array of lines in the ground continues to increase. As the ground becomes more congested with utility lines, it's vital to locate utilities accurately – gas, fiber, water, telecommunications and sewer – to ensure the safety of your

crew and protect your bottom line.

The first step before digging is to contact your state's One Call office and give them the location of the area to be excavated. A One Call contractor will visit the site and mark the locations of the utilities.

One Call contractors do a good between types of lines.

job of marking existing lines and pipes. However, due to interference, the marks may not be as accurate as needed. In some cases, privately owned lines not known by the One Call contractor may not be marked.

Many contractors show up and begin excavating. That's fine if the One Call markings are accurate. However, a mark could be 6 inches off and you may not find that line. Now you need to make a decision: Do you keep going or contact the One Call contractor and ask them to come back out?

Either way, it costs you time and money. However, if you have utility locating equipment, you can confirm the marks that are on the ground and Active locating involves searching for a specific line using either the direct connection or the inductive method. In the direct connection, the contractor connects a transmitter to the line or pipe to be located by hooking cable leads, similar to jumper cables, to an above-ground structure (for example, a fire hydrant in the case of a water main locate). This imparts an alternating current down the cable or pipe that can be detected by the receiver.

The only issue with this method is gaining access to facilities. For example, a user who is not a contract locator for the telephone company cannot legally open a telephone pedestal to clip onto the line.

Virtually all manufacturers are putting more output power into their utility locators. While this extra power does not enhance accuracy, it does provide a clearer and higher-quality signal, which is beneficial as more lines are being installed using horizontal directional drilling at greater depths.

identify underground facilities that could have been missed.

#### Understand methods

In locating technology, there are basically two methods: passive and active. Passive locating is used to check for unknown lines. The contractor sweeps the area with a receiver. This method detects any frequencies created by energized power and radio signals being radiated by utilities. However, it does not allow the operator to distinguish between types of lines.

To overcome this, contractors can use a locator with inductive capability. Here, the user sets the transmitter on the ground, and it emits a signal that induces a current in the pipe or cable. The receiver then can detect the target utility.

#### Where to start

The industry offers two types of locators — single- and multiple-frequency units — to accomplish active and passive locating. Each unit has its advantages and limitations. Single-frequency locators have been

around for decades. These systems consist of a transmitter that is placed on the ground and induces a single high-frequency signal.

The signal is picked up by the underground line and then radiated outward so that the receiver can detect it. Single-frequency systems work well on lines and pipes in uncongested easements, but putting a high frequency into the ground in a congested area tends to "light up" everything underground, and that may produce a distorted signal.

In other words, the user cannot

tell whether the signal comes from a power, gas or communications line. The other limitation is that most single-frequency locators cannot determine the depth of the line.

Since lines and pipes are constructed of different materials (copper, aluminum, iron, steel, etc.), the optimum locating frequency differs for each one. Multi-frequency systems (some offer up to five frequencies) allow users to tune the frequency being put into the ground to the type of line or pipe being located. A lower frequency reduces the chance that the frequency will jump from the target line to another nearby line. That makes it easier to distinguish, for example, a gas from a water line.

Some locators offer a current measurement index (CMI) that measures the current being put onto the line or pipe. This helps distinguish the type of utility, especially if it cross-

users ensure that they are staying on the original target line and are not jumping to other lines in the area.

Most modern receivers can also estimate the depth of the line or pipe at the push of a button. The locator measures signal strength and uses an algorithm to convert the information to an estimated depth. Although interference may distort the depth estimate, the user still gets an idea of the line's location before digging or hydroexcavating.

#### Changes on the horizon

While locator technology has changed little in the past five years, several manufacturers are adding enhancements.

Virtually all manufacturers are putting more output power into their utility locators. While this extra power does not enhance accuracy, it does provide a clearer and higheres over another line. It also helps quality signal, which is beneficial as able to pick up the unit and recall

more lines are being installed using horizontal directional drilling at greater depths.

Many manufacturers have also made advancements in receiver software to help filter out noise in the ground and air. The other trend is linking locators with GPS devices to enable mapping of utility lines with latitude and longitude coordinates. This provides accurate location for future reference.

While it's important to select a utility locator that includes the technology necessary for the most common jobs, the devices also should be simple to operate. The simpler the operation, the less training users require. Ideally, operators should be able to use the unit after only a brief instruction, rather than a day-long training class. Operators may not use the unit for a week or more. In that event, they should be

how to use the unit without further instruction.

Durability is also important. Operators take the equipment in and out of their trucks every day and may not handle it with absolute care. A locator must be durable enough to handle jobsite conditions. Weatherproofing is a desirable feature.

Locators can cost \$1,000 to \$4,500. While that may seem like a large expense, it is an investment that can pay off simply by helping to prevent one bad mistake.

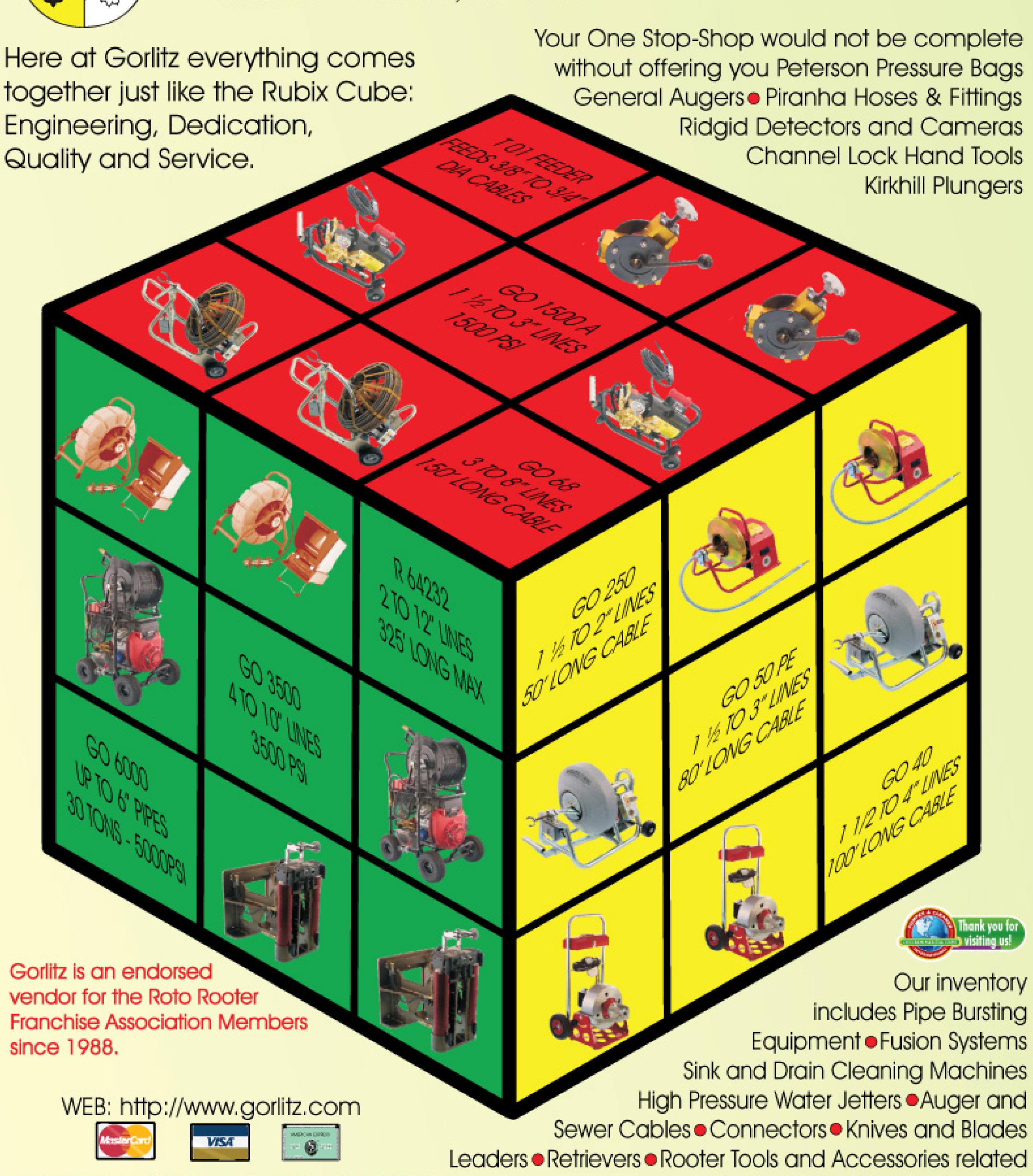

# Where Ther's Smoke ...

The Municipal Pipe Tool Co. uses a simple testing protocol to identify sewer leaks – which often become repair business opportunities

The Municipal Pipe Tool Co. Inc. is an established and diversified firm, offering maintenance and trenchless rehabilitation for sanitary and storm sewers and conducting infiltration and inflow studies throughout Iowa and surrounding states.

The company, based in Hudson, lowa, has offered smoke testing for almost 40 years. Though it accounts for less than 1 percent of annual revenue, smoke testing provides an important component in the company's arsenal of diagnostic tools. Because the tests require only a blower and a source of smoke, testing can be offered without tying up investment capital.

The company was founded in 1963 as a sales agent for Sewer Equipment Co. of America. It began servicing sewer and water lines in 1967 with the formation of Vic Gearheart & Son.

An early adopter of technology, the company purchased one of the first waterjet machines west of the Mississippi and owned and operated one of the first CCTV sewer inspection systems in the area. The son in the company name was Steve Gearheart, still a consultant with the firm.

"The televised inspection was very primitive," says Gearheart. "We were shooting in black-and-white, and as we moved the camera, the light bulb would crack and the camera would leak. It would sometimes take three to four passes to complete an inspection, and we would take Polaroids of the television screen to present to clients."

#### Smoke rising

The company became involved in smoke testing in 1972 with the advent of the federal Clean Water Act. "Smoke testing was an easy and cost-effective way to find the sources of extraneous inflows into the sanitary system," says Gearheart.

"When you're looking for a sewage leak, the rule seems to be that you find it under the last stone left unturned, and smoke testing leaves no stones unturned. I'd estimate that the number of cities that don't have a problem with inflow and infiltration at the bottom side of 10 percent."

Municipalities were eager to request the service, because federal incentives reduced the cost of smoke testing to about 10 cents on the dollar. Municipal provides collection system management services to more than 200 communities in Iowa, Minnesota, Illinois, Nebraska, South Dakota, Missouri and Wisconsin in a territory that covers a radius of about 150 miles.

The initial flurry of smoke testing engagements gave way to a more moderate pace. Gearheart recommends that municipalities smoketest their systems at least once every 10 years to help to assess pipe degradation. Besides being prudent, that establishes a routine compliant with EPA recommendations for collection system maintenance.

"Smoke testing isn't the only way to go, but it's one of the tools we have available in our toolbox," Gearheart says. The company also provides smoke testing to industrial and residential clients, but these calls are less common.

#### Weather-dependent

Smoke testing can help trace uncapped or abandoned lines as well as detect leaks. For example, the company used smoke testing to help a John Deere manufacturing plant in Cedar Falls map out its

sewer system. Recent one-off clients include a high-rise apartment complex and a church.

The smoke testing season is limited to snow-free months. Frozen soil and snow cover impede the passage of smoke, masking pipe leaks. June and July are prime months for smoke testing, although the company has tests as late as December. No license or certification is required for smoke testing, so the company differentiates itself through professional conduct and results.

"Conducting a proper smoke test requires industrial blowers and consistent smoke production," says Todd Patterson, operations manager. "We've heard of contractors just tossing smoke bombs down a manhole and hoping for the best, or using a residential window fan to blow the smoke around. That's just not going to do anything for the client. I've also heard of smoke bombs used in unventilated sewers, where the bomb has ignited the gas and blown off the manhole covers for several blocks around."

The market for smoke testing equipment and supplies is limited to a few major players. Municipal Pipe purchases most of its equipment

and supplies from Superior Signal Co. Inc., a company with almost 50 years invested in commercial smoke supply sales. "They're reliable in their deliveries, and they're very consistent with supplying and updating their Material Safety Data Sheets," says Patterson.

#### Marking air movement

Smoke testing is almost a misnomer for the process: It's actually an air-pressure test. Air is forced into the system at 800 and 4,000 cfm, and the smoke marks the movement of the air.

To create air pressure, Municipal Pipe crews use a Superior Signal Model 30-S/L Blower that fits over a sewer manhole. The gasoline-powered unit works with either petroleum-based liquid smoke or water vapor smoke candles (on smaller residential jobs, the contractor uses an electric blower, the Superior Signal 5-E).

The blower is started before insertion into the manhole to avoid

creating sparks that may ignite sewer gases. Smoke testing for municipalities usually requires a three-person crew, which typically covers about 10,000 linear feet of line per 12hour shift.

Once the smoke is generated, the team disperses along the length of the lateral flow, two scanning the right and left sides of the street, while the third member walks down the center, examining the street and catch basins. When they detect leaks, they record them on video for the client.

"Some clients expect to receive photographs of the testing, but I always tell them that shooting video is so much better," says Patterson. "On a still photograph you can barely make out a wisp of smoke, but on a video you can actually see it moving. It's the difference between night and day."

The crew can also train the video camera on street addresses and nearby intersections to help clients pinpoint the location of the leaks.

#### Ready to repair

If smoke testing uncovers a leak or other problem, Municipal crew members can often repair the defect.

"If it's something we can help with, we're right there to fix it," says Gearheart. The company has a substantial fleet of cleaning, inspection and repair equipment that includes:

- Four Camel combination trucks from Super Products LLC.
- One combination sewer cleaner from Vac-Con Inc.
- Three inspection vans from RS Technical Services Inc.
- A grout van from Telespector.
- Three TV inspection and lateral reinstatement vans, two from Aries Industries Inc., and one from CUES Inc.
- A manhole rehabilitation trailer from AP/M Permaform.
- Four boiler trucks, two refrigerated trucks, and two refrigerated trailers used for cured-in-place pipe lining.

#### WHICH SMOKE WORKS BEST?

Although it's called smoke testing, contractors can choose between two entirely different types of testing products. On one hand there's petroleum-based smoke, and on the other, simple water vapor produced by smoke candles. Arguments for either choice run from simple preference to the ability of the smoke to carry for longer distances, or to remain suspended in the air longer.

"The water vapor has better buoyancy, has 10 times the optical density, and has been known to blow successfully through huge storm water lines for over a mile," says Frank Nichols Jr., president of Superior Signal, a manufacturer of smoke testing products. "Petroleum-based smoke can't do that. At trade shows, however, I have people telling me they prefer one smoke over another, for completely opposite reasons."

The Municipal Pipe Tool Co. uses petroleum smoke for sewers and vapor for home and business applications. 'We prefer petroleum smoke for sewers because it provides a large volume of smoke, and once you start to feed in the liquid it produces that large volume for as long as you want it," says Todd Patterson, operations manager.

"In a large sanitary sewer line, we'd rather just start up the smoke blower and have it produce those volumes consistently instead of feeding in smoke bombs that might produce 40,000 cubic feet of smoke, but generate it for only three minutes."

For smoke, at least, the best choice is in the eye of the beholder.

## Under the Gun

An emergency cured-in-place pipe repair enables a veneer mill in Oregon to pass its Department of **Environmental Quality inspection**

n old 6-inch vitrified clay pipe running along the face of a 100-foot cliff in St. Helens, Ore., had cracked. Sewage streaming through it quickly created a 5-inch hole, sending the flow down the cliff to collect in an unpaved area of the Boise/Cascade Veneer Mill parking lot.

The Department of Environmental Quality was scheduled to inspect the mill in four days. An uncontrolled raw sewage spill would cost untold dollars in fines and close the mill until the area was decontaminated. The situation required an immediate response.

Justin Rush, engineer I at the City of St. Helens, met with Sondi Edwards, project manager for Zwald

#### What lies beneath

Loose soil, rocks the size of bowling balls, and litter covered the cliff's rock face. Safety was paramount, as the ground shifted with every step. "The trickiest part was knowing where to start," says Edwards. "We were in uncharted territory, trying to develop safety strategies without full knowledge of potential dangers."

Edwards called safety adviser Greg McDonald of Public Works Supply Inc. in Donald, Ore., for advice. He recommended the safety equipment to purchase and called for a rope-grab system for workers to use as a lifeline when scaling the cliff. Footing was treacherous. "Boulders slid under our feet as accepted the challenge. Strapped in

Industrial Services in Tillamook, Ore. "We stood at the top of the cliff and stared down at 211 feet of pipe running mostly underneath a bed of blackberry briars on unstable ground," says Edwards, who recommended a cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining system from Perma-Liner Industries Inc.

In one of the most complicated jobs in the company's history, Zwald established a bypass system, lined 150 feet of pipe, and met the mill's inspection deadline, all with a perfect safety record.

soon as we applied weight, and overgrown vegetation made it impossible to tell whether our next step would be on ground or on nothing at all," says Edwards.

Little of the trail following the pipe was visible or traversable. Clearing a path through the impenetrable briars posed another major problem. "Walking along the edge of the cliff was dangerous enough without operating a gasoline-powered, metal-bladed weed trimmer," says Edwards.

Certified installer Steve Neal

his safety harness to the lifeline anchored at the top of the cliff, he cautiously worked his way up the path, being careful not to tangle the line in the metal blade. After many grueling hours, he had blazed a trail to the top of the pipe.

#### Sanitary bypass

A temporary bypass rerouted the sewage and prevented further leakage. Neal and lead technician and certified installer Eric Manning carried 20-foot lengths of 6-inch 3034 snap-fit PVC pipe up the cliff, while other workers snapped the sections together from the bottom up. They followed the contour of the sewer line, which had ample slope to maintain hydraulic flow.

The Zwald crew plugged the old sewer with a pig at the hub in the manhole and detached the pipe

at a joint. Using a Fernco QwikSeal connection, they hooked up the bypass, deflated the pig, then walked the entire line checking for leaks. None appeared.

To stabilize the bypass line over the Memorial Day weekend, workers

lashed it to trees or drove 18-inch stakes in the ground. They coned off the contaminated area and work site to keep out unauthorized persons. City officials visited regularly over the holiday to verify that the line was undisturbed and not leaking.

On Tuesday morning, the Zwald crew arrived with the Perma-Liner trailer. They cleaned the old pipe with a Spartan mini-jetter, televised the line using a Ratech pushrod camera, measured the length of the repair, marked the start and stop points, and laid out 160 feet of liner material.

"We chose the Perma-Lateral single-access pipe relining system because we could position the air inversion tank at the top of the cliff and connect directly to host pipe with the delivery hose," says Edwards.

Everything associated with the lining process – calibration tube (heavy-duty balloon), pull tape, resin, oil, plywood – was measured and double checked for accuracy.

N DE LA CONTRACTION OF THE PARTY OF THE PART

The team connected the 15-foot delivery hose with inversion head to the air inversion tank, then practiced swinging the hose over the edge of the cliff and using the rope tied near the inversion head to lower it to the open end of the host pipe. "We did everything we could to plan our safety and the installation process," says Edwards.

#### Wednesday morning

The team's meticulous preparations paid off. Working on a plasticcovered plywood sheet, they impregnated the felt with two-part resin, then rolled the liner into the air inversion tank. Edwards quickly scaled the cliff to position the inversion head and signal when it was safe for air pressure to invert and blow the liner through the pipe. She repeated her journey to insert the calibration tube, which was inflated to 14 psi to force the liner against the walls while the resin cooked.

Four hours later, the crew removed the calibration tube and

inspected the work. "Our liner marks were dead on, and the liner looked awesome," says Edwards. After removing the bypass system, Dan Jones Conveyor Trucks Inc. in Portland delivered several cubic yards of gravel, covering a portion of exposed, unlined pipe to help prevent damage from exposure.

The City of St. Helens removed the contaminated soils where sewage had seeped, sanitized the area, and backfilled it. On Thursday, DEQ officials had no issues with that portion of the mill's property, and no evidence remained that Zwald Industrial Services had ever been there.

## Dealing With Tough Floor Drain Jobs

Contracting professionals share thoughts on the proper cable configuration for reaching from drains into laterals with potential blockages

#### Question:

When you clean a floor drain and into the 4-inch main line, what is the strongest cable that will pass through the trap but give you the most torque if you encounter a tough blockage in the 4-inch pipe?



#### **Answers:**

What do you do if you run your cable through the floor drain (1 1/2- or 2-inch pipe) and into the lateral a (4-inch pipe) and the blockage is a ball of roots? Now you can't get the cable wrapped in roots back through the smaller drain line. In my opinion, going through the smaller line to clean the lateral is a bad idea.



Ideally, you want a 4-inch cleanout to clean a 4-inch line, but that's obviously not the case here. You really can't clean a 4-inch line through a floor drain, unless you know for sure there are no roots or other hard stoppages downstream.

For example, I have a burger joint that calls me about every three or four months. No roots, all grease. The entire mainline is only about 20 feet long to the grease pit. The problem is that the largest access in the kitchen is a 3-inch floor sink.

Outside is a one-way cleanout.

Ideally, they need to install a 4-inch, two-way cleanout to enable cleaning back on the line. As it stands, the best I can do is a 1/2-inch cable with a small blade. Honestly, I'm surprised the drain lasts as long as it does between cleanings. They won't pay for a two-way cleanout or for a jetter, so they get a minimum warranty.

As for your situation, what size is the trap? Are you using an open-wind cable or closed? You need to know these things first.

#### Question (cont.):

For sure I'm not going very far into the 4inch line. The floor drains I'm asking about
are what I call 1950s vintage: 3-inch grate
but on the other side of the trap is usually 2inch pipe. If I recall correctly, a maximum of
10 feet of 2-inch pipe was allowed before it
had to terminate into a 4-inch pipe. I use 5/8inch open-wind cable. It feels good in the
hand, but I think it could feel better.

I have 1/2-inch tight-wind inner core loaded in an Electric Eel Model N, but I haven't tried it. I'm considering Electric Eel Dual-matic 5/8-inch (open-wind and small inner core). It is intended for the Model N but could be nice in a RIDGID K-50, too.

#### Answer:

The main thing here is to not get hung up and stuck. That's very easy to do when working through an access that is only half the size of the problem pipe, especially if there are heavy roots. Given the access size, you're not likely to get much of a cutter through the trap. An open-wind cable can typically negotiate the trap and turns easier than a closed-wind and is good for softer stoppages. Although I prefer to use closed-wind cable due to the ability to really torque down on roots and harder stoppages..

It's best to not force the cable too much in a situation like this. Take it slow and easy and you'll be OK. Pull back the cable and inspect it to see possibly what you're dealing with downstream. If you're unable to at least get it open and draining with either a cable or jetter, then your customer needs to make a decision on a repair.

## **Opportunity Knocks**

Contractors protecting their customers' long-term interests find that a drain-cleaning service call often leads to more work to correct the root causes of stoppages

here's no better time to remind customers of all your capabilities than when you've opened a drain line and can talk about a problem straight to the customer. While some operators seem to consider "upselling" a dirty word, others see opportunity in pointing out other issues that might soon require another visit while the pipe is exposed and the technician is on site.

Without taking advantage of people who are already dealing with a

problem, savvy contractors

recognize the chance to increase their value in a customer's mind by explaining what other problems are lurking in the plumbing. Most operators seem to take a natural approach to suggesting extra services, pointing out the potential cost savings in avoiding repeat service calls. They also depend heavily on modern technology to back up their recommendations.

"When we do any work, we want the homeowner to be there, so they can make decisions themselves," says Barbie Dawson, owner of Crowe Inc., Roanoke, Va.

"We have the homeowner right there seeing what we're seeing.

"We pride ourselves on our honesty, and the fact that nothing is done unless the homeowner authorizes it. So if we unstop a line and then camera it and find something that's causing the stoppage, we want the homeowner to see it."

Crowe serves half residential and half commercial customers. Technicians encourage commercial customers to be on hand for televising. They then explain what the problem is, what's causing it, and what it will cost to repair.

"If it looks like the whole line's bad, they have the options to replace just that part or replace the whole thing," Dawson says. During the process, technicians identify any collateral issues, but Dawson says the service call is intended mainly to address the original problem, not to look for others.

"Our technicians' first concern, of course, is to open the line and take care of the problem that the customer initially called for," says office man-

ager Maridee Dukett. She takes some of the calls that

come in to AALCO Septic & Sewer Inc. in Knoxboro, N.Y., which provides grease trap and graywater pumping and drain cleaning.

"But once they're in there and see that maybe the line has a lot of grease or a particular problem, then they'll tell the customer how they can address that long-term. They may recommend waterjetting to get all that gook out of the line. They might find a low spot in the line while they're using the camera equipment, and ask the customer if they've experienced recurring problems." If so, they'll explain how the low spot could cause the issue, and what it would take to fix it.

But once they're in there and see that maybe the line has a lot of grease or a particular problem, then they'll tell the customer how they can address that long-term.

"Typically, one of the first things they do to find out what's wrong is clean the line. If they come across a place where they find a root or a large amount of grease, it's a fairly simple upsell to a waterjetting service, because that's what needs to be done to take care of the problem. It's really what's needed to keep it from recurring as opposed to cable cleaning, which just clears a path instead of removing the stoppage."

Dukett says upselling isn't a company policy so much as it's the way the technicians are trained to deliver real value to clients. After 15 years working for plumbing companies, Johnny Menser, owner of Tri-L Enterprises, in Nebo, Ky., decided it was time to make more

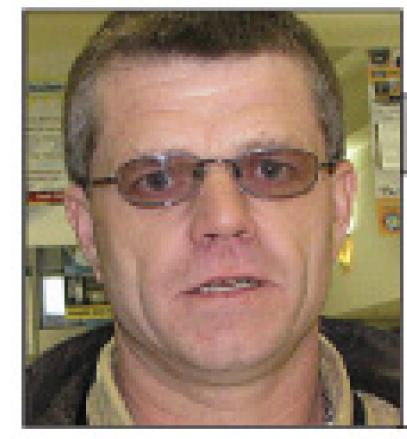

money for himself and went out on his own. He likes being able to call the shots about the way customers get treated. Although he doesn't intentionally set out to upsell, customers often sell themselves on extra work because they can clearly see it needs to be done.

"After I go out and hear them say that they've

had a problem four or five times, I access the prob-



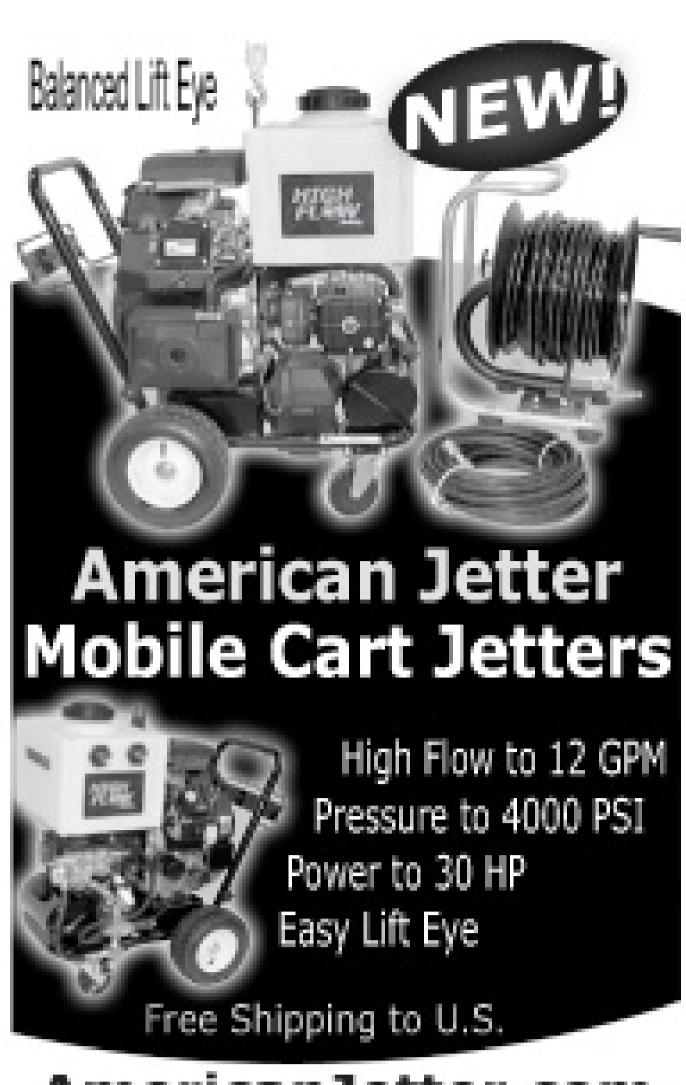

lem, then take my cable and try to unstop the pipe," says Menser, who works in northwestern Kentucky.

"Then I talk to my customer about actually seeing where the problem is in their line." He asks the customer to be present for televising – he finds their presence helps him make the sale.

"I drop my video camera in, run it down there and show them where it's broken, or collapsed, or where roots may be intruding," he says. "Then I suggest that we replace that part of the line." The video is convincing, and he burns a DVD of the inspection that the customer can keep. That helps remind them of the value of his work.

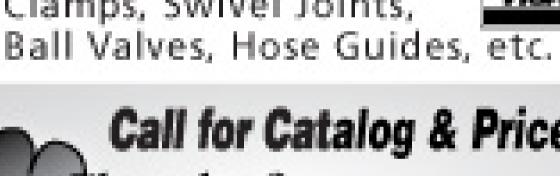

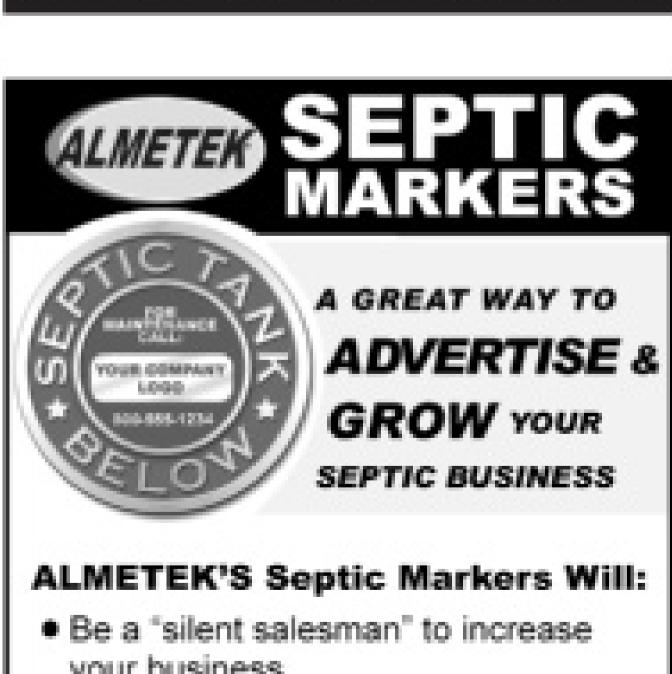

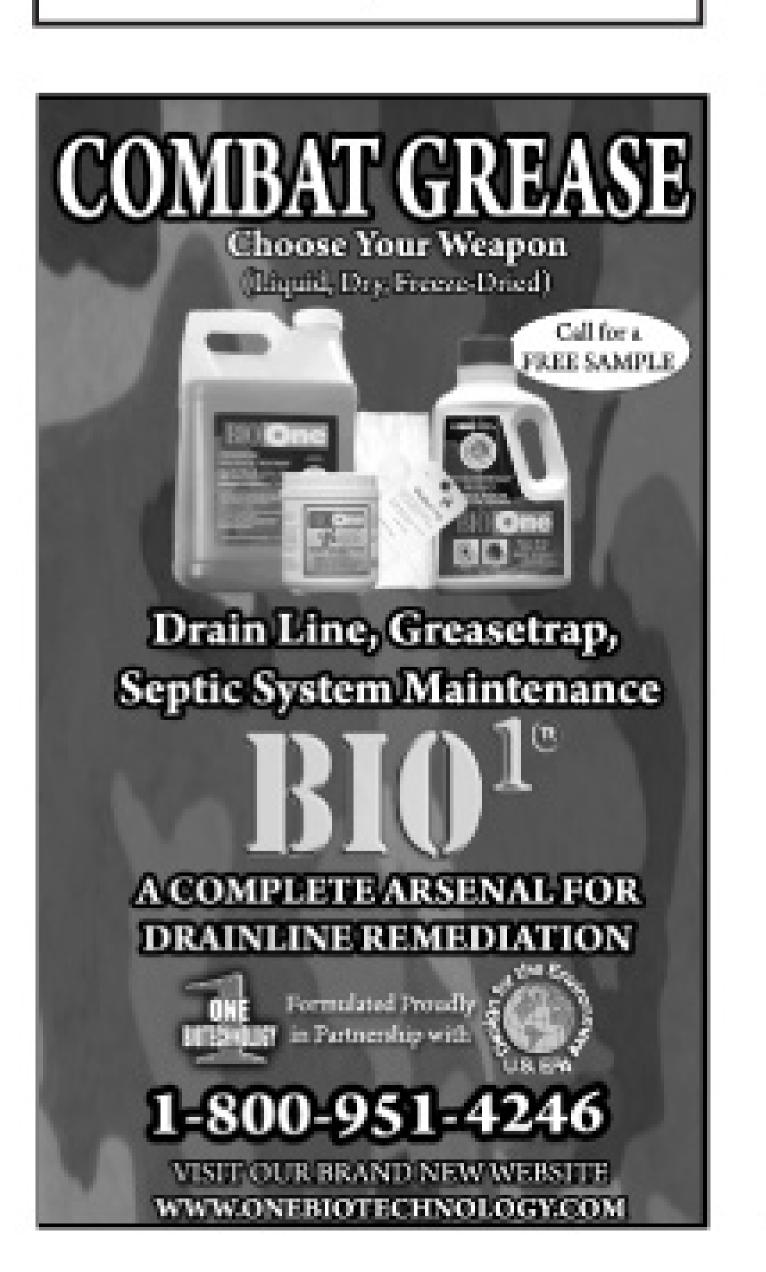

## Product Spotlight

### Push Camera System Built for Versatility

he VeriSight push camera system from Envirosight LLC offers drain cleaners multiple sonde frequencies, interchangeable camera heads, digital recording capability, and self-diagnostics.

The company's aim was to deliver a push camera system that cost less than its previous model but still included the features users expect, according to Richard Lindner, president. The unit includes a universal controller that works with any camera or reel.

The system, designed for plumbing contractors and municipalities, offers sonde frequencies of 512 Hz, 640 Hz and 33 Hz. This allows technicians to locate pipes at varying depths and made of materials from cast iron to PVC to concrete.

Interchangeable camera heads allow technicians to inspect different pipe sizes. The most popular option is a 1.7-inch self-leveling head that can inspect 4-inch laterals. Each camera delivers 420

HTVL resolution and has a scratch-resistant sapphire window. A 6- to 8-inch adjustable skid is available.

"A dimmable LED array produces a lot of light, which is always a challenge in these environments," Lindner says. Other camera options include 1.5-inch and 1.3-inch heads. The digital recording capability eliminates the need for DVDs or videotapes.

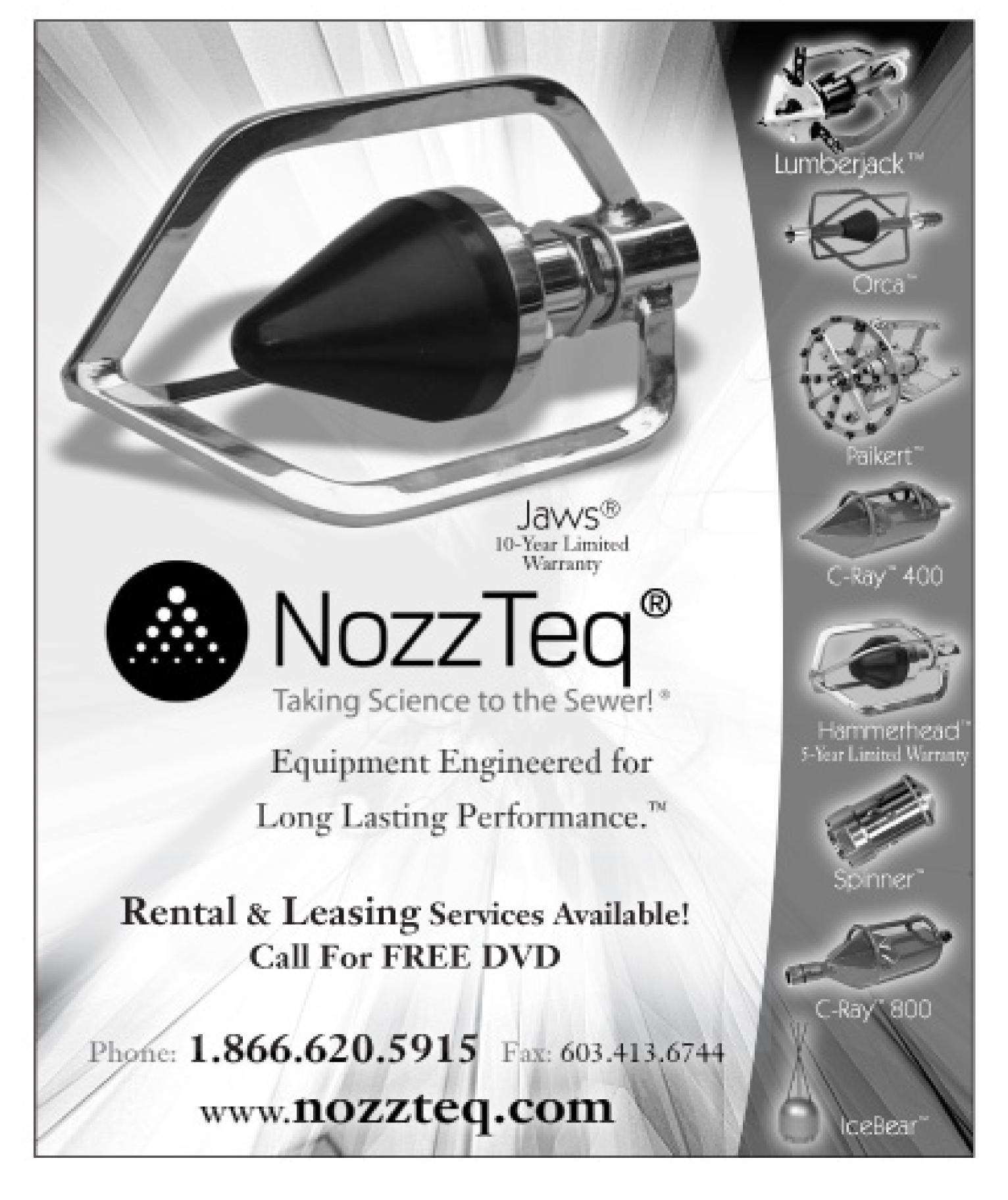
"Video footage goes right on the hard drive," says Lindner. From there, a USB 2.0 port lets users upload inspection results to a PC, then e-mail them to customers. The graphical user interface and intuitive menus make recording easy.

A 60 GB on-board hard drive stores 45 hours of MPEG4 video. Other features include an 8-inch recessed color display, analog and digital connectivity, a full-size waterproof keyboard with hot keys, a microphone for inspection narration, a footage counter in feet and meters, and a water-resistant ABS housing. A maintenance kit lets users trace problems

to the camera head, controller or cable.

"That way, customers don't have to send in the whole system for repair," Lindner says. "Service diagnostics are a big issue because the cameras really take a beating. An owner can get a repair part overnight and save on downtime and shipping."

Other features include a welded stainless-steel frame, a 200-foot Kevlar-reinforced push rod (12 mm or 10 mm), and spring shock absorbers in the wheels. For information: 973/252-6700; www.envirosight.com.

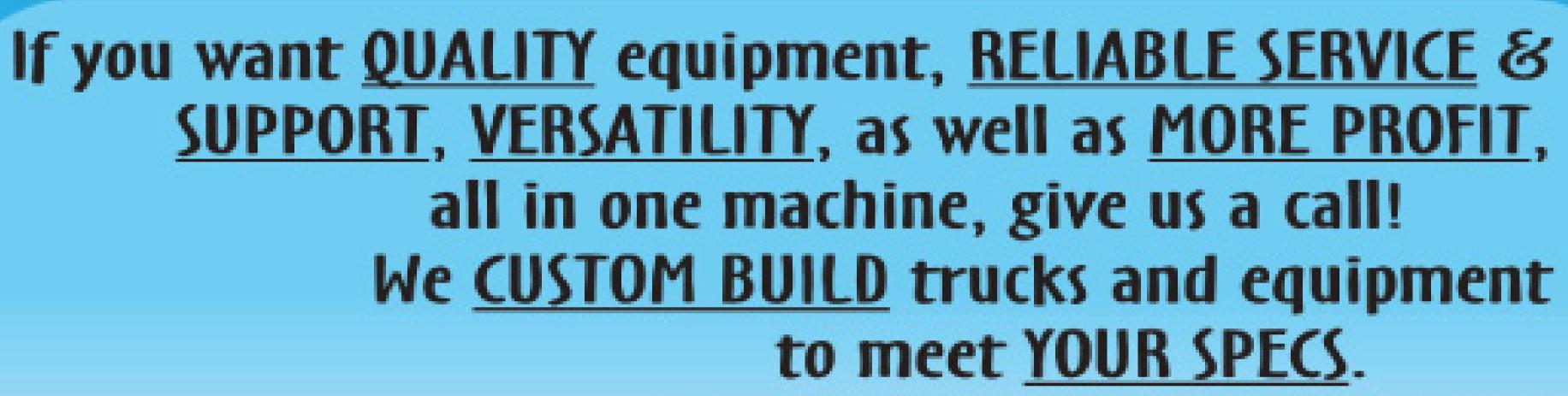

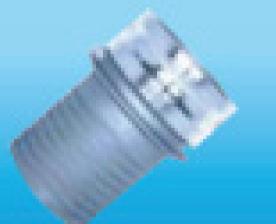

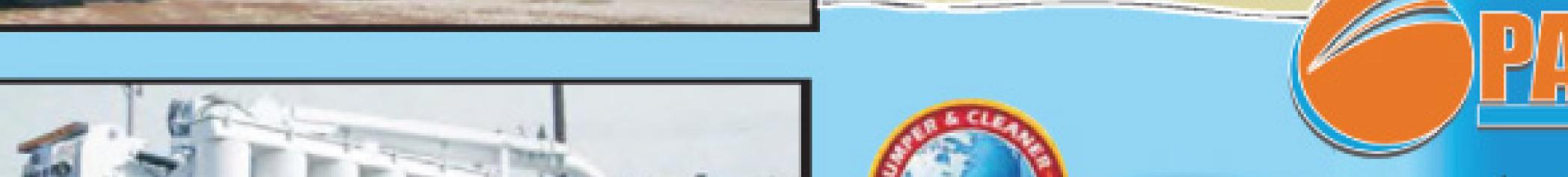
