



wrote my column for this issue yesterday. This isn't it.

I was reading through it one more time this morning and I thought it was pretty good, but it didn't at all reflect how I'm feeling at the moment.

I'm a huge hockey fan. I've played the game my whole life, from age 3 to today at 44. I'm not a TV guy. I like to be busy. I sit all day at work, and when I get out, I need to move. But when the Stanley Cup playoffs start, I'm glued to the set. Last night, the Washington Capitals claimed their first cup in franchise history. I'm a fan of the Capitals' division rival, the New Jersey Devils, but after the Devils exited in the first round of the playoffs, I started pulling hard for the Capitals. I watched every game.

To be fair, I'm also an emotional person. I always shed a tear or two when the winners hoist the Stanley Cup. It's an appreciation for the game, for the unbelievable dedication and effort it takes to get to that point, and probably a little honest recognition that I'll never feel anything quite like that sense of triumph in my life. I've never been that dedicated to anything.

T.J. Oshie was one of the first players interviewed after the Capitals' Game 5 victory. He's a player I really like, and I shed a few more tears as he choked up talking about having his dad, who has Alzheimer's disease, in the stands to see him achieve a goal they've both dreamt of for many years. It made me think of all the things my mom has missed and will never get to see and share.

And of course, there's Alex Ovechkin — one of the greatest goal scorers to ever lace up a pair of skates, who seemed doomed to never reach the summit — skating around holding 35 pounds of silver over his head, with pure, unbridled joy on his face. You don't have to be a hockey fan to appreciate it.

I read about a dozen recap stories this morning. And then, I turned to some different news. Anthony Bourdain had been found dead after hanging himself. I didn't know him. Never met him. But I watched his shows and appreciated the way he explored the world and exposed his viewers to other cultures in a simple, human way. He showed how much we all share in common.

We all want to leave a legacy. For Oshie and Ovechkin, it will be engraved on the Stanley Cup for eternity. People will remember their greatness. For Bourdain, it will be those things I mentioned, but also the sadness and tragedy of taking his own life. I don't really think of myself in terms of a legacy, but I do think about our purpose here and the impact we make.

What's your legacy going to be? What role do you play in your family, this industry and your community? They're questions worth considering, and those answers should inform the way you approach all of those things.

I hope you take advantage of the opportunity you're given to make a positive impact.

# Embracing THEGALL

A lean start laid the foundation for a life in the sewer and drain industry By Lee Allen // Photography by Mark Henle

n a business that's generally pretty dirty, Hugh McLaughlin has a clean conscience -even after nearly 40 years' of sewer and drain work.

"Since day one, I've tried to be consistently fair, overwhelmingly honest, and provide just the service needed — no upsell," says the owner of Quality Drain Service, doing business as 88 Drain, in Tucson, Arizona.

"I hope, more times than not, that I'm making the right decisions, the fair decisions, the value-driven decisions. Sure, there have been some lean times, but I'm always able to sleep well at night because of how I conduct business. I like helping people, and that's one reason why a service business and I do so well together."

It hasn't always been easy, but McLaughlin has stuck to his values and walked the straight and narrow in both business and life.

#### **AN EARLY START**

Despite the standard teenage idealism, he decided early that he'd never be what he aspired to be, either a rock star playing to thousands of adoring fans or a major league third baseman. "But this is the path I was given, to be of service to people, and I embrace that."

McLaughlin got his start while he was in college, working long hours at a restaurant. "My dad, a Navy Seabee familiar with the construction world, suggested there was always a need for sewer and drain cleaning providers and I could do that work on the side while going to classes. I was studying business and figured this would be an interesting way to apply what I was learning in the classroom to real-world life."

Thus, Quality Drain Service got its start with a strategically chosen name — "I picked it because Q is

Every service tech in this industry can provide stories — some humorous, some horrendous — about their experiences in the field.

With nearly 40 years in the business, in and out of thousands of homes and businesses, Hugh McLaughlin, owner of Quality Drain Service in Tucson, Arizona, has his own set of unique experiences to share.

"No diamond rings, but we've retrieved a number of plain gold wedding bands over the years," he says. "If you pull off a sink trap, you'll often find an earring or maybe a bracelet. And with toilets, we've taken anything that will fit in there out of there. Our finds include everything from false teeth to eye glasses to dog toys, TV remote controls, and cellphones.

"We used to joke that whatever toy prize the hamburger joint was giving away in the kids meal was what we'd find in toilets and tubs that week.

"We do a lot of hair salons, and when we clean out a sink filled with hair, we frequently hear, 'Oh, that's so gross,' from the stylists. I'm thinking: Oh, yeah, well you wash everybody's dirty heads, but at least I get to wear gloves on my job.

"If you've ever had children, there's nothing you didn't see in a diaper that's going to be any worse than what we encounter in this job."

But the kicker story deals with a call to a hotel where people had been living and raising chickens in one of the rooms. "I don't think the birds ever went outside because when we got a call about a clogged bathtub, we found it full to the top with chicken waste. Even for me, this was, by far, the most disgusting service call I've ever been on."



right before R in the phone book and Roto-Rooter was the big name company. I wanted my ad to be seen on the same page. 88 Drain is our phone number and registered trademark, so we started answering calls with '88 Drain."

McLaughlin wrote up some handmade flyers and beat the pavement trying to develop a customer base, gradually getting a sporadic call or two; and the routine got established — finish a class, go do a service call, then go back for another class. "By the time I'd finished my schooling, I'd created this nice little business that paid decently and allowed me to be

self-employed, and that was important to me. Over all these years, I've never collected a paycheck from anyone else."

Like most startups, the early days were tough. "I bought my first vehicle, a beat-up gray primer van, for a couple hundred dollars. It leaked oil so badly, I'd pull into a service station and say, 'Check the gas — and fill it up with oil."

He says at first, a good week might have brought in a total of 10 service calls, which was huge. Nowadays, he takes 10 calls before noon.






#### **BUSINESS MATURATION**

The company specializes in residential and light commercial sewer and drain cleaning, as well as other drain-related services. "We respond to homeowner problems involving clogged sewers and drains including any and all toilet repairs. We also help folks locate their sewer clean-outs and work with them in preventive care for all their drains," McLaughlin says.

His initial toolkit didn't contain much. While he was mentoring with a couple plumbers who gave him a subcontract job or two, he'd buy a used





snake from one and haunt swap meets and used-tool supply shops, grabbing a tool here and there, buying inventory as he truly needed it. He ran so lean that if he needed a seal or a toilet part, he'd have to make a trip to the store each time because he didn't have enough money to keep inventory on hand.

"The first time I made a thousand dollars in a month, I thought that was a big deal. And in 1980, when you're only 19 years old, it was." As the business grew, he'd budget for a more expensive piece of equipment. "Eventually, I got to the point where I could actually pay cash for a new ladder or buy a pair of gloves that didn't already have holes in them."

Today, McLaughlin and his crew have a more robust stable of equipment to lean on. "We use Spartan Tool equipment, modern state-of-the-art equipment with the latest technologies in sewer and drain cleaning. One of our favorite tools is the Spartan 300, which allows us flexibility in unclogging sewer lines from roof vents if a clean-out is unavailable at the time of service, providing some kind of plumbing relief to customers until a clean-out can be established."

Among his fondest early-day memories — the day he bought his first new van where everything worked and the vehicle bore his company logo on the side. He worked for nearly 15 years as a solo act, laboring 6 or 7 day weeks and on holidays. "It wasn't like I had this tremendous volume of work coming in, and even if you had a family birthday party on a Sunday, if the

pager went off, you'd answer it and go out on a \$20 or \$25 service call. This is a specialized sector of the plumbing industry, a niche, so there weren't a lot of big-dollar jobs. A lot of our calls involved the minimum payment, so you had to do quite a few of them before they added up.

If they had water flowing down their hallway, they wanted someone, a real person, who would answer the phone, not a machine asking them to leave a message. If you weren't there for that one customer, they might go find somebody else and never come back."

#### STAYING AHEAD

Slow and steady over the years, the business now has five on-the-road service technicians in addition to McLaughlin, who answers calls, coordinates dispatch, and is lead communicator between the customers and his service techs. Wife Cheri does all the bookkeeping and accounting for the half-million-dollar-a-year business.

"There's about 400 different companies in town that incorporate a little bit of what we do: the national firms, as well as guys who work for

plumbing companies that also do side jobs and others, like handymen, maintenance men, and people who have left full-time careers but still do jobs on the side. And we're competing with all of them. But we've always kept our prices reasonable and have had nice steady growth with some long-term customers of 30 years whose children are now our customers too.

"The excitement of unclogging a drain has diminished over the years, but I still love the

interaction with my customers as we provide quality service at a price people can afford." (88 Drain's minimum service call is \$65 with average actual cost about \$93 per call.) "It's like having a large extended family, and it's nice to know you're part of the fabric of their life, woven into it to some degree."

At age 57, McLaughlin says he'd do it all over again. "I've learned a lot over the years and there are some things I'd do differently, but the base values of how I operate my business wouldn't change — my core values would stay the same. And I'll be doing this as long I'm able, probably right up until they throw dirt on my face because I still love what I do and that keeps giving me the ability to do what I love." **c**

# 7 Tips for Budget-Friendly Marketing

Strategic planning will help you get the most bang for your buck when trying to reach top customers

#### By Andy Slipher

llocating marketing dollars can seem like an arduous and even dicey process to decide how much to spend annually and on what. For some, it's the autopilot response of last year's budget, plus 3 to 5 percent. For others with limited marketing dollars, it can mean the equivalent of putting all one's eggs in a single basket.

These are examples of the extremes, but not altogether unheard of in marketing.

But, all the same, there are effective ways to plan, allocate and intelligently spend marketing dollars on your business. Each involves a step backward from the narrow framework of the budget while interjecting the purpose of the marketing into the practice of budgeting dollars toward success.

Here are seven best practices to follow in any marketing budget process:

#### 1. Think bigger

Don't limit your marketing to media in the traditional sense. Go beyond even digital and new media. People immediately equate marketing spending to media. What if you could spend your marketing dollars in a way that would mean reaching your target, but not having to dump lots of dollars on big media? Marketing is also promotion, incentives, rewarding loyalty, creating positive experiences, enhanced service, direct communication with the customer, sales, relationship building, or any combination of these activities.

Begin to think how you can most efficiently impact customer conversion. Don't be afraid to be dramatic. Let your mind wander to big ideas, then find ways to work around your limited resources. If you need help, bring someone in from the outside to challenge your thinking. None of this has to be expensive — just effective.

#### 2. Build the cost of marketing into your services

Have you accounted for the cost to market and sell your drain cleaning service? It's too easy to say, "We're not spending enough on marketing." But you're handicapping yourself if you're not building marketing into the cost of operating your business. In short, you're cheating yourself by not being realistic. Drawing customers (large or small numbers) to your service is an inherent part of selling. Your resources — usually in the form of people and money — need to be allocated for such activities.

#### 3. Target

This might seem obvious, but consideration of your specific target customer in your spending strategy can make your marketing budget go much further. Knowing your best customers inside and out will enable you to do this. You don't have to speak to the universe. Just speak to your universe. Focus on the essential few with the highest chance for conversion. Budget and spend your acquisition dollars toward them first. Then, migrate out from there. If your target audience is too big, you probably don't know enough about them. Look, listen and learn in order to segment. It is well worth the time.

#### 4. Focus on behavioral change over attitudes and awareness

If you're short on marketing dollars, don't even think about building awareness. Forget about promoting good feelings about your brand or service. Instead, focus on differentiation, an emotional hook and getting the customer to act. Demonstrate why you're better, engage them in an emotional decision and call them to action. No cheesy or cliche come-ons. Be dramatically and truthfully different in a way that convinces your customer to give you a try. Attitudes follow behavior.

#### 5. Treat marketing as an investment

If you want it to yield a return, you must treat marketing as an investment. One of the biggest mistakes by some marketers today is throwing around the term ROI (return on investment) in conjunction with their marketing spending while treating it as an occasional or periodic expense. This is hypocrisy. If you want long-term, sustained ROI from your marketing, treat it as you would a true investment (in your service and business). Remember: The "I" in ROI stands for investment.

#### 6. Strategy first

This is the single most valuable tool in your marketing arsenal. Thinking efficiently and with reverence to clearly defined marketing and business goals will help you distill goals, intentions, and plans guiding you to determine how much to spend and where to spend it. Speaking from experience, the practice of strategic thinking takes a load of time and guesswork away from determining where to best spend marketing dollars.

#### 7. Zero-base your budget

If you've made it as far as a strategic plan, a zero-based marketing budget should come as no surprise. Your strategic goals, business and marketing objectives will lead you to tactical media spending. Start from scratch so that your spending matches what you're wanting to accomplish. You'll be amazed at how focused a budget it can yield.

#### THE BOTTOM LINE

Budgeting for marketing is far less complicated when you can approach it with greater intention and priorities in mind. Follow these tried-and-true practices and your marketing budget process will be a much more effective

## **Paying for Your Golden Years**

When planning for retirement, first tally your projected monthly expenses and then work toward a realistic nest egg

#### By Erik Gunn

ow much does it take to retire? Conventional wisdom once suggested if you could put aside a million dollars, you'd be set for life when you were ready to kick back. That's a faulty assumption, says financial advisor David Sandstrom. First, a million dollars isn't what it used to be. But more to the point, as a ruleof-thumb target, it's simplistic and could lead you astray.

Sandstrom is a vice president and general securities representative at Landaas and Co., a Milwaukee-based investment advisory and planning firm.

Of course, this column can never substitute for a conversation with your own financial advisor, who can bring an understanding to your personal circumstances. What follows are general suggestions — not investment or financial management advice.

#### INFLATION

The first flaw in the million-dollar theory is that "over time, inflation has eroded that million dollars to something that is probably not going to be a major windfall for everybody," Sandstrom says.

Your nest egg should be large enough that you'll never need to tap into it. "We usually look at a rule of thumb that says, 'I don't touch the nest egg, and I live off what the nest egg can produce," Sandstrom explains.

And that, too, needs to be more than you might think. You really should live off only part of the annual earnings, and plow the rest back into savings.

Here's why: With a balanced portfolio — say 50 to 60 percent stocks and the remaining 40 to 50 percent in bonds — historical averages suggest you'll see an annual return of about 7 to 8 percent.

Now, consider that inflation has been about 3 percent a year for a long time now — sometimes a little less, sometimes a little more. To keep pace, the dollar value of your annual payout actually needs to go up every year. For that to happen, the base savings needs to keep growing, too.

"If you're going to leave something in there for inflation every year, so that you can give yourself a little raise, that would probably leave about 4 to 5 percent for you to spend," Sandstrom says, not the full 7 or 8 percent. "If you spend all of the return, you're stuck with that million bucks the rest of your life. You're not going to keep up with inflation."

Sure, you'll get \$70,000 to \$80,000 a year in income — but in 20 years, that won't buy you as much as it does now. So if you're starting with \$1 million and hold back part of your earnings to build your savings up, you'll only be able to take out about \$40,000 to \$50,000 to live on in that first year.

Only you can decide if that will pay your expenses comfortably. But unless that's what you're already living on, chances are the answer is no.

#### A NEW APPROACH

Besides the impact of inflation, some costs will rise considerably once you're retired. Yes, some expenses may go down. Perhaps you've paid off a mortgage, you're driving to work less, or maybe even trimming your clothing budget. But other costs will go up, Sandstrom warns. No. 1 is health care: "Health care costs are becoming a very significant hurdle for people retiring, especially if they retire prior to going on Medicare." (So much for taking early retirement at 55, 60 or 62.)

Another culprit: Your savings — that nest egg — carries a lot more of the burden of supporting you in retirement. Traditional pension plans are vanishing, for one thing. Or, as Sandstrom puts it, your retirement resources "used to be Social Security, a pension, and whatever you'd saved. Now it's pretty much gotten down to Social Security and what you've saved." And for most people, "Social Security is not an answer for retirement. It's a supplement."

What all this adds up to is a completely different approach to calculating a retirement target rule of thumb. And it's not a one-size-fits-all number.

So how do you set your retirement savings goals?

"We ask clients, 'What's your number? What do you need a month?' It varies so much across the board," Sandstrom says. "I have people who do fine on Social Security alone every year, and I have people who spend all their Social Security every month and draw lots of money out of their portfolio — and they complain about not having enough. It all depends on the individual."

Once you have calculated what you think you'll need to live on per month, plan "well in advance with those numbers in mind," Sandstrom says. Ideally, you'll want to save enough so that skimming a little more than half of the earnings off every year — that 4 to 5 percent — will provide you with enough income.

#### WHERE TO PUT IT

When you're ready to tap into it, where should you put that savings? That question is complicated by the historic low interest rates over the last decade or more — great for borrowers, but not for savers. That's pretty much undermined a longtime traditional retirement savings parking place — the bank certificate of deposit.

Today, "The safer stuff that you'd like to own in retirement doesn't pay you anything," which "puts a little bit more pressure on what that number is for your nest egg."

Maybe simple, safe, high-interest savings instruments will come back someday, but don't expect them any time soon. So the nest egg needs to be big enough to allow for some higher-risk, higher-return investments that can deliver a potential windfall. But if those collapse, you don't want them to undercut your long-term plan.

Sandstrom suggests maintaining a broad portfolio balanced between a level of risk you can tolerate and a level of security you can maintain over time. Make sure some of your investments are in "something you're just drop-dead positive" will provide steady earnings at low risk — high-quality bonds, for instance.

Then, if the riskier part of your savings hits a rough patch, you can afford to leave it alone until it recovers and tap into the safer side of the portfolio. "Just don't spend assets that have just been discounted."

#### THE BOTTOM LINE

To sum up: Forget about a \$1 million target. "It's not the million dollars. It's having a plan," Sandstrom points out, one that will let you draw on your savings that amount you'll need each year for the rest of your life. "Get a good handle on what you think your retirement needs are going to be, then figure out, 'Can I get

# ALLINTHE ALLINATION AL

Second generation's focus on underground work builds a new foundation for New York plumbing shop

Residential. Industrial. Commercial. R.I.C. Plumbing pretty much does it all, but it was underground work that really elevated the company.

Rick Kuhns was focused on plumbing when he started the company in 1982, but since his sons Scott and Adam came on board, the company has put a greater focus on underground work while expanding their business across western New York state. The Lockport-headquartered company sustains steady growth by building on its professional reputation, with a willingness to innovate and do great work.



"We want to keep the quality of our work as high as we possibly can," Adam says. "I tell a crew if a job takes a day or two days, fine. Do the job to the best of our ability. Keep the craftsmanship up. The most important thing for us is our reputation."

The good name of the plumbing house began to form shortly after Rick graduated from high school. As a high schooler in need of spending money, he had worked as a summer and weekend laborer for a friend's father, who was a master plumber. Upon graduation, Rick formally began his apprenticeship. In ensuing years, his work ranged across the gamut of plumbing tasks, including factory work as a pipe fitter. In 1984, he became the youngest person to that date to earn a master plumber license from the city of Buffalo.

But, as entrepreneurs are wont to do, Rick became disenchanted working for others and started his own company. Relying at first upon



some at-hand residential remodeling, he then took on commercial jobs and finally — after the factory called him back as a contractor — industrial work. (It was his wife, Karen, who took note of the range of jobs and matter-of-factly suggested the R.I.C. Plumbing name.)

#### **GROWING THE FAMILY**

Today, the company is a far different plumbing house. It is a twogeneration family firm that has developed specialties around the interests and skills of the family's three master plumbers. Rick's son Scott, like his father, got into plumbing work as a high schooler and became a full-time company man in 1998.

"Dad had bought a backhoe a year or so prior to that," Scott says. "We lived in an area where a lot of infrastructure was aging, and doing that work became a viable thing. I really enjoyed that end of the work." It was the beginning of the company's shift in focus from pipes in buildings to pipes underground.

Then Adam joined his brother and father at R.I.C. Plumbing. It was not a long-anticipated move for Adam, who was schooled as a chef. Professional kitchen positions were scarce, however, and Adam was not


inclined to relocate from the Buffalo area. Furthermore, he had met his future wife. "I wanted to buy a house and I needed a steady job, so I joined the company."

The culinary industry's loss was plumbing's gain. "We work well together," Adam says. "We each have our own understanding of what we

are good at. Together, we took the business a little further. The need in our area for underground work was growing. Scott and I were good at it and our employees enjoyed doing it, so we pursued it. It really worked out. We developed a really nice mix of sources of income."

Two and half years ago, Rick moved laterally to become vice president of operations. Scott became president, and Adam, vice president. In all, the company employs 14 people, including secretary Elizabeth Nasca, who is the social media specialist, and Melanie "Mel" Lisiak, a friend of Rick's grandfather. She helped Rick set up his office 36 years ago. "She was instrumental at the start and still is," Scott says. "Mel is basically our grandmother."

"I tell a crew if a job takes a day or two days, fine. Do the job to the best of our ability. Keep the craftsmanship up. The most important thing for us is our reputation."

The feel of family runs through the company. Including the Kuhns, three father-son teams work with equipment and one mother-daughter duo work in the office, none of them related to the Kuhns clan. "We have a strong family ethic here," Rick says.

#### **GOING UNDERGROUND**

Scott credits his brother's decision to join the company with a move to modernize the company's equipment and better meet the demand of fellow  $\frac{1}{2}$ 



plumbers wanting underground help. "We invested heavily in new equipment and new technology. Adam was a big part of upgrading our equipment."

Before long, R.I.C. Plumbing became the company for industry peers to call for underground repair work. "Now we do work for a number of other plumbers who have solid businesses, but they don't have backhoes and trenchers and excavators," Scott says. "It has become sort of a niche market for us."

The mix of equipment evolved along with the company's focus. The original JCB North America backhoe was joined in the equipment yard by a Bobcat mini-excavator — and then a second one. Today, the backhoe, four small excavators, two trenchers, a Spartan Tool jetter, and a Ditch Witch FX30 vacuum excavator testify to the company's subterranean mission. A 9-ton Case CX80 excavator is also in the mix, a midsized digging machine acquired to perform heavier work for a petroleum company and subsequently used

for underground tasks for the Tops Friendly Markets chain. R.I.C. Plumbing also operates a full complement of trucks — three pickups, two small service vans, two larger sewer vans and four dump trucks — and several trailers.

Then there's the smaller equipment. In 2000, the master plumbers recognized they needed a pipeline camera to really know what was going on down below and bought a RIDGID model, which still is in use. Four Vivax-Metrotech cameras are also kept busy, sometimes chasing frogs through pipes as shown in an amusing video on the company website — www.ricplumbing.com.

#### **BREAKING INTO BURSTING**

R.I.C. Plumbing's busiest pieces of equipment, though, may be its pipe bursting machines. At a trade show, the Kuhns plumbers saw a Pow-R Mole Sales pipe bursting unit and were intrigued. When a job subsequently came up that seemed an ideal candidate for pipe bursting, the company rented the

equipment without much intention of being a repeat customer. However, a second opportunity arose and Rick suggested they invest in a machine. The company did, though Scott admits he wasn't keen on the idea. He lauds it now. "It was one of the better moves we've ever made."

The company now owns a Pow-R Mole PD-33 lateral pull device with a pull force of 60,000 pounds that can burst cast iron pipe (or clay, polyvinyl chloride, concrete, etc.) up to 6 inches in diameter. The company also owns Pow-R Mole PD-2 and PD-6 units, which are push-or-pull pipe insertion or bursting devices, and some auxiliary equipment.

Adam says after seeing Pow-R Mole's products at the trade show, they became acquainted with a dealer in Lancaster. "They are in our area. The products are good. They are convenient. If we ever had a problem, we could resolve it the same day. If a machine went down, they would have another one right there for us."

In fact, pipe bursting is now the biggest component of R.I.C. Plumbing's business — two or three jobs a week. A recent undertaking involved an 80-foot-long 4-inch residential sewer line that had collapsed. R.I.C. Plumbing used two of its Pow-R Mole machines. A rod was pushed the length of the line, a cable attached and pulled back through and then new pipe pulled into place. The efficient task required two workdays. Still another tool — a Source One Environmental point repair system — is used nearly every day to fix pipes.

Having the right tool available for whatever task arises is a principle instilled in the company by



#### Shoring up safety measures

Most of the underground work R.I.C. Plumbing performs is trenchless. It's a big and growing part of the business. Yet even trenchless solutions sometimes require excavation for insertion of equipment.

Furthermore, in western New York, sewer lines are run relatively far underground to mitigate freezing problems in winter months. "The lines are deep, deeper than most people would think," says Adam Kuhns, company vice president. "Our average depth is about 8 feet."

OSHA requires that trenches or access holes deeper than 5 feet — or shallower if an on-site competent person has determined that a cave-in is possible — must have a shielding or shoring system in place to protect workers. Obviously, the OSHA rules come into play in many of R.I.C. Plumbing's projects. As a result, the company has trailer space dedicated to carrying shoring components to job sites. "We carry shoring on a trailer with us on every job," Kuhns says.

Construction job fatalities increased sharply across New York state in 2016, the latest data-reporting period, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. Most were not from workers being buried under collapsing trench walls, however, so going through all the trouble of unloading and setting up shields or shoring can be tough to justify by experience.

As for R.I.C. Plumbing, it invariably employs the safety equipment. "Once we decided to use shoring all the time, we quickly found it was worth it," Kuhns says. "Putting the shoring in place seems routine now."

Rick. From day one, he says, he taught his sons what he had learned early on: "If there is a tool that will help do a job more efficiently, buy it. There isn't a tool out there that we haven't bought or haven't used. We are very aggressive on the amount of equipment we use on our jobs. It makes us very efficient at what we do."

#### **MAINTAINING OUALITY**

At one point, Scott began referring routine residential plumbing calls to other plumbers but soon learned that customers really preferred R.I.C. Plumbing because of its reputation. So two other master plumbers were hired for house repairs, complementing the two full-time underground crews run by Scott and Adam.

In all of this work, the company remains wedded to the Buffalo area. particularly Tonawanda and Amherst and other northern residential suburbs, though commercial and industrial work is undertaken almost anywhere in the region. The Kuhns are united in wanting to see the company grow, but not exponentially.

"We try to maintain a low trajectory of growth. For example, we average about one to 1 1/2 new employees a year," Scott says. "We've had opportunities to go bigger more quickly, but we don't want to. We want to manage our growth so the quality of our work doesn't suffer." c



## **Secure Your Site**

Planning is key to protecting pedestrians in and around your job sites

ome jobs may seem too small to sweat over the idea of public safety.

There are a hundred little things on a job site that can potentially endanger the public; that's why having a foolproof plan for every single job, big or small, is more than good practice.

As Richard Crow, regional manager with Murphy Pipelines Contractors, says: "It doesn't matter how much money we make, or how big the project is. If somebody gets hurt, that job is a complete failure. We lost."

Possibly the most vulnerable members of the public around job sites are pedestrians.

#### THE BASICS

Dealing with safety means dealing with hoses and cables, walking routes, and potholes, among other challenges and obstacles.

"If an access pit is left overnight, the site has to be secured with construction fencing and a temporary cover," Crow says.

There are many options for temporarily covering pits. A spare piece of plywood doesn't necessarily do the trick — to reduce risk and liability, contractors should consider a specialized device, such as the raised plastic pothole covers available on the market.

When working with hose or cable, sometimes access is an issue, and often contractors must cross lanes of pedestrian traffic.

"We use ramps for our lines, made for pedestrian and traffic bearing,"  $\mbox{\sc Crow}$  says.

Other jobs may require more elaborate solutions. When Ecotech Hydro Excavation was vacuum excavating debris from a hospital basement, the crew parked its GapVax truck across the street and stretched the boom over the road. Scaffolding carried the hose over a sidewalk to protect pedestrians walking beneath.

Depending on the service, having the appropriate number of people on site is also important. Use spotters when necessary to ensure that bystanders aren't getting too close.

"A lot of times you'll get the wanderers that come up and they just want to know what you guys are doing," says Anthony Chavez, safety compliance officer for Davids Hydro Vac. "If you don't have that extra guy, they may go into an area that you've already excavated or they may not pay attention to the caution tape or the cones that you have set up."

The last essential is insurance: You always hope nothing bad happens, but if it does, it's important to be covered. As Crow says, "We have coverage in case something happens — lightning does strike."

#### **MAKING THE PLAN**

"We are out here providing a service, and generally there are some specs or guidelines in providing pedestrian safety or vehicle safety," Crow says. "I think it's crucial for all parties to have a review process when you're submitting something for pedestrian or community safety.

"Understand what the construction crews are going to do during the day: what access they need, to and from the site," he says. "A lot of times people are worried about the site itself, but you have dump trucks and other large deliveries coming through the site every day. And how are they going to off-load? How are they going to pick up?"

The first step when approaching a job plan is to survey the job site. Murphy Pipeline Contractors' supervisors start with a drive-thru, followed by an aerial survey via Google Earth. They use that aerial map to analyze routes and traffic, then sketch out necessities for that particular job.

"After we kind of agree on the plan, then we'll formalize it and apply some industry-standard traffic control or pedestrian safety," Crow says. "It could be not just traffic, it could be sidewalk. How are you going to detour people around sidewalks? How are they going to access it?"

The plan is submitted to necessary authorities such as the municipality, county, or state Department of Transportation and reviewed by the client. After approval, the plan is distributed to site superintendents and foremen to be implemented on a daily basis.

"Basically, we'll have to submit something, base it on Florida DOT index standards or county standards; and generally speaking it could be site-specific — not related on a specific standard — but just a plan you'll have to create and submit to the client or client's representatives for approval," Crow says.

#### **GETTING THE WORD OUT**

"Messaging is really important. It's easy to put up a few cones and some detours around, but if you don't notify the public in advance, it just causes confusion. So properly notifying them way in advance of any obstructions, detours or obstacles that they might come upon is really good."

Crow knows firsthand the danger of this topic: Before working at Murphy Pipelines Contractors, he was the client on a job where the contractor picked up some signage before the site was clear. As a result, a woman rear-ended a dump truck and was killed in the accident.

"That contractor made an error by picking up his traffic control plan too early and was still having issues out there within the clear zone that could impact traffic. And unfortunately it did; she lost her life."

#### CONCLUSION

Often, in construction, all you can do is roll with the punches. But having a solid safety plan and understanding of the site before work begins allows you to make those on-the-fly changes with confidence.

"Generally when the job starts, things change. It's just construction; it's the nature of the beast," Crow says. "We consider the safety plan a working document, so we continually review throughout the progress meetings.

"This gets lost amongst a lot of contractors, engineers, and even clients: No job is too small, or too big. It should be the same thorough process. I think once a party assumes that a job is too small, that's when issues are going to come up," he says. "You just don't want to miss anything when it comes to safety." C

## Less Filling, More Jetting

Wastewater-recycling vacuum truck amps up productivity and revenue through fewer trips for water refills

#### By Ken Wysocky

magine how much more productive your jet/vac truck could be if you didn't need to leave the job site a half dozen times a day to refill its water tank. At Commercial Sewer Cleaning, crews don't need to imagine such a scenario, thanks to a Camel Maxxx 1200 water-recycling vac truck that boosts sewer cleaning productivity 20 to 30 percent, compared to a conventional vac truck.

Under optimal conditions, the Camel — made by Super Products — can operate all day on one 1,500-gallon tank of water, which significantly reduces costs on jobs where the Indianapolis-based company must pay for the water it uses. In some situations, it can even arrive at a job site with an empty water tank and use just the water from a sewer line, says Dennis Young, president of the company, which was established in 1965 by his father, Reford Young.

"If the sewer is relatively clean and the water flow is decent, we can run all day off one initial load of water," Young says. "That's significant because I'd say that 75 to 80 percent of the time, we have to pay for water, as well as rent a hydrant meter to track our usage."

In addition, municipalities in the company's northern Indiana service area increasingly are telling contractors they can get water only from one specific fire hydrant. That's because some hydrants and waterlines are so old that municipalities don't want the hydrants turned on and off repeatedly for fear of rupturing a pipe

or overagitating rust and iron inside the pipes, which can turn a neighborhood's tap water brown, he explains.

"If we're lucky, a fire hydrant is right where we're working," he notes. "Or it might be 250 or 300 feet away, so the farther out we go during cleaning, the farther we have to go back to get water. From a production standpoint, that just kills us.

"And on the sewer cleaning side of our business (the company also does industrial cleaning and sewer inspections), everything is production-based," he adds. "So the more footage we can clean per day, the better off we are. With the Camel, we might get as much as six or seven hours a day of straight production because we're not stopping to get more water. We make more money jetting than we do chasing water."

#### **LESS WATER TO TREAT**

Moreover, by recycling the water it uses on cleaning jobs, the Camel also saves municipalities money by not sending more water into sanitary sewers for treatment. "On an average job, we might put 20,000 gallons of waste down a municipality's sewer," Young notes.

The Camel also enables crews to operate more safely in high-traffic areas because they aren't stringing hoses through streets. Young notes one recent sewer cleaning project on U.S. Highway 40, in which the crew never had to break off to get water; that's a huge safety factor when the truck is situated in the middle of four lanes of traffic.

Built out on a 2018 Freightliner 114SD, the Camel 1200 features a 12-cubicyard debris tank; 1,500-gallon water tank; Roots blower from Howden(4,500 cfm); water pump with pressure and flow of 2,500 psi/100 gpm; front-mounted control panel; front-mounted hose reel with 270-degree rotation and capacity for 1,000 feet of 1-inch-diameter hose/600 feet of 1 1/2-inch-diameter hose; 26-foot-long boom; and an 8-foot hydraulic extension boom.

In a nutshell, here's how the wastewater-recycling works: After debris and water enters the waste tank, a device called an ejector plate compacts the solids. As it does so, water passes around its edges to the rear of the tank, leaving the solids behind. From there, the water passes through a filtration screen and then through a centrifugal separator and a Y-strainer with a stainless steel filter. Then it's fed into the jetting water pump, ready to be used for further cleaning. The filters must be periodically flushed to prevent small grit and debris from damaging the water pump.

#### **A CONVINCING DEMO**

Commercial Sewer Cleaning invested in the vac truck in August 2017 after watching a demo of its capabilities. "It looked like it would make life a lot easier without having to always drag hoses around to fire hydrants, trying to get continuous water," Young says.

The company also owns five Vactor combination sewer vac trucks with Roots blowers (Howden); a Super Products Camel nonrecycling vac truck; a trailer-mounted water jetter (18 gpm at 4,000 psi) made by Harben (a subsidiary of Flowplant Group); and three liquid-waste vac trucks, two manufactured by Cusco with Hibon (a division of Ingersoll Rand) blowers and one built by Quality Tank with a National Vacuum Equipment blower.

Young says the Camel Maxxx is easy to operate, though it takes a little while longer to learn how to use it, compared to a conventional vac truck. "There's just a couple more steps you have to do in order to operate it, and you have to clean the filters more often," he notes. "The filtration screens are self-cleaning, but you still have to do a hard flush with freshwater every so often. But you don't need to be a mechanical engineer to run it."


There's no question the Camel Maxxx costs more than a conventional vacuum truck. But Young expects a good return on the investment. As he puts it, "We're in the production business, and the better the production, the better the income."

Moreover, Young estimates that the truck already has recycled more than 900,000 gallons of water. "That's 900,000 gallons less that we've put back into the sewers here in Indiana." C





## Waterblasting and Waterjetting Cleaning and Accessories

## WATER BLASTER PREPS HISTORIC BUILDING FOR REFURBISHING

**PROBLEM** / In Chicago, a historic structure stood ready to be refurbished into an up-and-coming Embassy Suites hotel. The structure, a former machine and fabrication warehouse, was coated with a lead-based paint that needed to be removed before any more work was started. The customer hired Nova Painting to remove all lead paint chips and possible lead-contaminated Blastox neutralizer from the 15th floor and safely get it to the basement.





**RESULT /** All runoff/wastewater was collected in a containment pond and pumped through the filtration system, where all solids were separated prior to purification; it was then pumped through the filtering system to be recirculated through the blasting operation. **800-394-4987**; www.aquamiser.com.



**PROBLEM /** Over 50 years' hardened sediment and debris blocked a critical 5-inch overflow pipe beneath the artificial lake at Dospat Dam, Bulgaria, seriously threatening dam wall integrity and risking catastrophic failure. Construction of a new conduit proved unfeasible, as the remote setting prevented use of heavy, trailer-mounted equipment. And the 460-foot line descended 2.5 percent to 157 feet beneath the dam wall through four tight bends to the outflow, making it extremely difficult to access the obstruction.

PROBLEM / Some of the initiatives that University of Central Florida utility workers handle daily include identifying and mapping the location of utility lines. ## Combo machine offers efficiency with big power

In the world of municipal sewer cleaning, efficiency is important. Increasing efficiency without sacrificing performance or power, though, can often prove difficult. The Titan dual-engine combination machine from Vac-Con is designed to attack those difficulties head-on.

The Titan, a truck-mounted combination machine, boasts a Dual Engine Drive System with Aeroboost Q Drive, which are upgraded hydrostatic and auxiliary drive systems that operate the vacuum and water functions, help lower noise emissions, and substantially reduce overall fuel consumption without sacrificing power.

"It's a design that we've actually had in development for five years," says Mike Selby, inside sales manager at Vac-Con. "It's designed to provide the same high vacuum power that our customers are used to, but at lower revolutions per minute."

The unit includes enhanced twin cyclonic separators, one located on each side of the truck, and is designed to optimize efficiency and filtration. The Aeroboost three-stage fan balances airflow, resulting in less turbulence and more power.

"Our goal was to build a system that came in under 100 dB of sound, and this unit was recorded at 96 dB," Selby says. "That makes it a great fit for work in residential areas, as it's going to be less disruptive than a typical combination unit."

In addition, an upgraded water system features 1 1/4-inch plumbing and ball valves. Its Aarcomm wireless remote is an integrated enhancement for use with the Omnibus Precision Power control system, designed to improve usability and efficiency. "It's a control system that allows the user to interface with everything via joystick," Selby says.

Other features include an upgraded hose reel swivel, 10-foot telescopic boom, 180-degree rotating articulating hose reel that can fit 600 feet of 1-inch hose, a flat industrial-style rear door, segmented boom elbow, electronic water level indicator with lights, a stainless steel debris tank level indicator, debris body flush-out, a splash shield, mainframe deck coating, a quarter-turn water tank drain valve, rear bumper with additional storage, hinged boom tie-down, aluminum toolboxes, Lazy Susan pipe rack, HD water system valve manifold, and a 2,000 psi water pump. It is available with an optional PD blower with multiple ratings up to 28 inches Hg and 6,000 cfm. Units can be ordered in 11-, 12- or 16-cubic yard capacities.
