

SHARE WHAT YOU KNOW

Connecting with other companies on social media is a way to share information and elevate the industry



O YOU HAVE A FRIEND in the drain cleaning industry? Another drain technician or business owner, someone who you can bounce ideas off of, get equipment recommendations from, and talk to about your business goals?

It's so beneficial to have someone you trust for these types of conversations — and if that person is in your industry, dealing with the same types of problems you face, they can provide you with insight that even the most well-meaning layperson just can't offer.



Any good friend can listen to you vent about a customer who won't pay their bill and hash out something that's been bothering you, but if that person isn't also out there jetting drainlines and inspecting laterals they probably won't truly understand the challenges you face. Any topic on the technical side of things will be out of their wheelhouse. But your drain cleaner buddy who just bought the new jetter you've been eyeing can be a valuable resource.

If you're in a small market, you might not want to get too chummy with your direct competitor — throwing business each other's way once in a while is one thing, but discussing new equipment or a service you want to add might be pushing it if you're talking to the only other service company in town.

Instagram and Facebook are both tools you can use to connect to the industry at large. Social media can have its downsides, but it's also a great way to reach out and learn from people you wouldn't necessarily ever meet or have access to "in real life."

I've heard firsthand from a couple drain cleaners who use Instagram to reach both customers and others in the industry. They use videos to take their customers along on jobs, showcase the work they do and how they solved problems for others. It's a great marketing tool. You won't find a better, more easily accessible way to show a prospective customer how you can help them than by showing a video of you solving a similar problem for someone else. Providing visual proof that you can do the same for them is well worth the time it takes to create a short video.

The drain cleaners I've talked to about this all mention how great it is to talk to others across the country, and sometimes even from other countries. They ask each other questions and give advice, sharing information that they probably couldn't get from a competitor in their area.

I love to hear about the collaboration and camaraderie. That friendliness and willingness to help each other out makes individuals better at their jobs and also works to elevate the industry as a whole.



For a small Los Angeles plumbing and drain cleaning company to use such a slogan might seem a bit over the top; but it reflects both the ambition and the work ethic of the man who started Koko Drains.

Krikor Chiranian is realistic. He knows what he's doing and where he's headed. The son of a plumber and veteran of 17 years in the industry, Chiranian — everyone calls him Koko — has exhibited vision and a sense of purpose from the beginning of his working life.

Helping his father as a teenager on a summertime plumbing call, he met Ole Bugarin on the job site. Bugarin was a drain cleaner and that day unclogged a line by inserting a snake through a cleanout. Chiranian watched and was immediately drawn to the work.

"Right then I knew," he recalls. "I knew I wanted to clean drains instead of plumbing. I told Ole, 'I may want to get a job. Are you hiring?' He said that as a matter of fact, he had just started his company and was looking for help."

Chiranian worked at Bugarin's American Rooter for nearly 10 years and set his sights on eventually serving the world.

BUILDING A FOUNDATION

Chiranian became adept at unclogging sewer and drainpipes, priding himself on overcoming whatever blockage he discovered. He was satisfied with his position at American Rooter right up until the day he had a conversation with A.J., a childhood friend. "Is this all you're going to do the rest of your life? You just want to work for a company cleaning drains?"

His friend touched a nerve Chiranian didn't even know he had. "That conversation opened my mind," he says. He began to dive into selfdevelopment literature, including such classics as The Laws of Subtraction, The Science of Success and The Secret of the Ages: A Master Code to Abundance and Achievement.

"Growing up, I had a rough childhood," he says. "I got these books and I read them over and over and over. Repetition burns it in the mind." From them, he learned to think big and to lay a foundation of rules and habits to build upon, including always giving your best effort.

"You should take pride in everything you do. People always are looking at you. I tell myself God is watching so I should always do the best I can. You never know who else is watching, too."

In 2013, Koko Drains opened its doors. Chiranian was still studying for his C36 plumbing license, so his work mostly was drain cleaning using mechanical snakes. He had a ready customer base because of his time with American Rooter.

"While working with Ole, I was making a reputation for myself," he



says. "Customers got to know me and the kind of work I did and after eight or nine years they started asking me why I didn't start my own business. I was kind of forced to start my business."

Once licensed, he added household plumbing — toilets, sinks, sump pumps — to his repertoire. When a clogged line was especially resistant to mechanical snaking or needed a thorough cleaning, Chiranian subcontracted the needed jetting work. However, jetting was in so much demand, he soon invested in a U.S. Jetting unit and now does the work in-house.

trucks that are unmarked by logos or the name Koko Drains. Chiranian does this in deference to plumbers who have called him to clear a drain for one of their customers. "I like to be loyal to the plumbers who give me work. If I come in with a truck with my name on it to help a plumber and the next time the customer calls me directly, it's sort of stepping on the plumber's toes."

In fact, Koko Drains at this stage is a little-advertised company. No logos on trucks, no ads in the paper or on social media, just some posts on an Instagram account. "We have a Facebook page

COMMITTED TO GROW

He's gone from being a one-man outfit to splitting work between him and two technicians and is looking for a third. David Fox came to Koko Drains as an experienced hand, having worked for five years for an LA franchise, Mike Diamond Plumbing & Drain Cleaning. His other technician, Stefano Assenza, was a drain cleaning rookie.

Chiranian's training of Assenza was handson — having the new employee ride along with the boss for six months. The first month. Assenza watched. Then he was given the opportunity to undertake one task or another under Chiranian's supervision.

"Finally, when I could see that Stefano could do a job and was comfortable taking on new jobs, I gave him a truck and sent him on his way," he says. "They are both young guys and always are happy to come to work. I get a lot of compliments about them."

The trio go on service calls in plain gray

and a website but there's not much evidence anyone looks at them. It's mostly word of mouth and referrals."

That marketing plan will change, though, Chiranian says. "Because we work for so many plumbing contractors, it sort of prevents me from advertising. But I told my wife when the day comes that plumbers don't need me, I'll start advertising more." That day may not be far off: He already has noticed a decline in calls from plumbers as more of them get into drain cleaning.

TOOLS OF THE TRADE

The business continues to evolve. Because Chiranian repairs and replaces failed sewer and drainpipes, he opted to acquire a TRIC Tools

X30 pipe bursting system. The X30 has almost 30 tons of pulling force and an 8 gpm hydraulic flow rate. It readily accomplishes the company's bursting and replacing of 4-inch and 6-inch laterals.

His longest bursting job so far replaced 80 feet of 4-inch pipe. "We don't burst pipe that frequently," Chiranian says, and that's partly by design. "I don't try to sell the pipe bursting as much right

now because whenever I do a job, I have to empty my work van of other tools and fill it up with bursting equipment. I'm getting a new box truck I ordered in August and I'm going to turn that into my trenchless truck."

Koko Drains fixes short sections of failed pipe using an APS Versa-Patch product that inserts a resin-sided liner where a pipe is broken and inflates it with a bladder until the liner affixes itself to the pipe. Chiranian currently subs out longer lining work, but by the end of the year, he plans to invest in a cured-in-place lining system.

He jets pipe with a US Jetting 4018 model, which produces 4,000 psi and pushes out 18 gpm. His choice of jetters reflects his commitment to growth and best service. "People at several companies told me to get a small cart jetter, but a lot of jobs a cart jetter can't do. The 4018 can work on pipe up to 24 inches in diameter. I decided I would

DIVERSE ORIGINS

os Angeles is a diverse city, as coastal metropolitan areas often are. Koko Drains reflects this diversity in the ancestry and nationality of company employees.

Company owner Krikor Chiranian is a second-generation Armenian American. His father was a native of Armenia who moved to Los Angeles 40 years ago from Beirut, Lebanon. Chiranian's one-person office staff, his wife, Arpi, also is of Armenian heritage.

One of Chiranian's two service techs is Stefano Assenza, a native of Italy.

"I first came to know Stefano on a service call," Chiranian says. "I was working on the job and one of the residents of the home said he had a friend who just came to America from Italy and was looking for work. He said the man worked on boilers in Italy and wondered if I would be interested in talking to him about a job. I told him I was interested."

He hired Assenza and made the new employee his helper, training him on the job. After a few months as an apprentice employee, Chiranian put Assenza to work with his own service

Chiranian is grateful to have stumbled upon Assenza. He says he has found that not too many Americans whose families have lived in the country for multiple generations are interested in plumbing work.

Chiranian's father learned the plumbing trade in Beirut. There, he told his son, the work is a little different because there are relatively few buildings constructed of wood. Instead, they are built of bricks and cement. So, running a pipe for a plumber in Beirut meant chipping holes in cement blocks and plastering the ragged openings after the pipe was in place. Installing a pipe in a wall formed of fir studs and drywall sounds pretty easy by comparison.

After he came to the U.S., Chiranian's father continued plumbing, introducing the craft to his children. Besides the Koko Drains owner, one other son is also a plumber. It's a family tradition.

invest a little more upfront and get the best machine so I can be confident going into every job that I'll be able to clear the pipe."

He relies on a couple of jetter heads — a bullet nozzle and ball nozzle along with a warthog nozzle to break through grease jams. He runs his inspection camera simultaneously with the nozzles to ensure a pipe is thoroughly cleaned. Because he guarantees his cleaning work, the camera is instrumental in warrantying the work.

His cameras of choice are RIDGID SeeSnake mini reels, and his newest units boast a high dynamic range that lets him see 4 feet ahead instead of 1 foot. They also incorporate tilt technology for changes of elevation in a line. Besides cleaning, the cameras are used for real estate transaction inspections. At least once a day, Koko Drains receives calls from LA-area Realtors.

For mechanical pipe cleaning, Chiranian pulls out Gorlitz Sewer & Drain cable equipment. His Gorlitz GO 68HD features 150 feet of 11/16-inch cable powered by a 3/4 hp reversible motor. "It's a very powerful machine. It does not stop. It is not made for an amateur drain cleaner."

He doesn't own a mini-excavator or other powered digger. Because most lines are laid pretty shallow in Southern California properties, "we do all our digging by hand. The only time you need an excavator is when you are digging in the street and I'm not licensed for street-digging."

GROWTH MINDSET

Half to three-quarters of his drain and sewer work is for residential customers. He's called frequently by commercial clients — fast-food restaurants and property management companies — and he is open to more commercial work. Recently, Chiranian completed a job under a 30-unit condo building, replacing 40 feet of 4-inch sewer line.

Repair and replacement of pipes is where Koko Drains can make the most money, he says. Yet drain cleaning keeps the company busy and requires less overhead. Some pipe in the Los Angeles area dates back 100 years, so there's plenty of potential work for the company. Aging pipe and tree roots keep him busy, too. Chinese elm and oak trees, among other varieties, are "tearing the pipes apart," Chiranian says.

Koko Drains has a one-person office staff — Chiranian's wife, Arpi. When he started his company, he did the books along with

everything else. His wife — then his girlfriend — worked for a tax firm. She didn't especially enjoy the overall environment of the work - liens on property, tax payments and so on.

"So I asked her to come work for me and she did. It was the best decision we ever made and now I can focus on the work and on growing the company."

Chiranian looks back to the beginning of his drain cleaning career and gives his first boss lots of credit. "Ole Bugarin was an honest man and taught me everything he knew. He was the hard job specialist. When others couldn't clear a line, he would. I learned that from working under him."

He has plans. He formed his company under the corporate banner of Right-a-Way Rooter — "When customers call, I tell them we'll have someone there right away." — but operates for now as Koko Drains. If the company expands and franchises, as Chiranian plans for it to do, he will pivot to the Right-a-Way name.

"A major goal of mine is to have an office in every state, and maybe one day be a worldwide company. That's

the kind of growth mindset we have. Whether it happens, we'll see. I just know that if you shoot for the stars, you might be able to grab the moon." c

INDUSTRIAL-STRENGTH SOLUTION

Robotic hydrodemolition equipment provides big benefits in many industrial cleaning applications // By Keith Armishaw

NDUSTRIAL FACILITIES RELY on high-pressure waterjetting machines for a number of specialized cleaning and removal applications to keep equipment operating at full potential. Enhancing efficiency for each task — from surface cleaning and preparation, to heat exchanger applications to refractory removal — is vital for maintaining productivity and profitability.

To help keep facilities running smoothly and optimize scheduled downtime, industrial cleaning contractors employ a variety of handheld and automated waterblasting equipment designed for these challenging applications. However, what these tools provide in terms of efficiency — and long-term benefit to the contractor — depends on many factors. Selecting the right equipment goes beyond how fast crews can get the job done. It must include considerations for safety as well as productivity. Additionally, equipment that allows an operation

to expand service offerings without further investment is the best choice for continued growth and overall stability

This has led a number of industrial cleaning contractors to invest in robotic hydrodemolition equipment from original equipment manufacturers. These cutting-edge machines offer a number of safety and productivity benefits compared to hand held equipment or homemade systems and increase contractor flexibility over highly specialized, single-application options.

IMPROVED SAFETY

Industrial cleaning applications come with a number of inherent dangers. Limiting crew exposure to these hazardous conditions is a primary concern for contractors and has led to the development of numerous automated options. The extent to which these solutions keep workers out of harm's way varies, as does the amount of personal protection equipment required. Due to the specialized harvie of

industrial cleaning applications, the use of automated equipment might be limited in some situations, leaving contractors to rely on more manual solutions — unless they have access to powerful robotic equipment.

For example, a contractor might be able to perform a basic tank cleaning application with an automated system, such as a rotating jet lowered from the top of the tank. But what if the project requires a more thorough cleaning or the removal of materials such as paint, coating or concrete? To achieve the necessary power for this type of cleaning, contractors often employ crews in full PPE wielding hand lances.

This method significantly increases the safety risks for crews. Because they must constantly resist back thrust, hand lances cause workers to fatigue quickly. A worker using a 40,000 psi hand lance must constantly fight up to 52 pounds of thrust (at a flow of 5 gpm) for normal operation. The Waterjet Technology Association recommends that, in ideal conditions, a single worker should not be required to withstand back thrust of more than one-third their body weight for an extended period of time. In poor conditions, such as low light, uneven or slippery footing, and confined spaces found in industrial cleaning applications, even less back thrust is recommended.

And, like all hand-held equipment, hand lances also come with increased risk of hand, wrist, shoulder and back injuries since they require workers' bodies to absorb the shock of the cleaning or removal process. Even more dangerous is the risk of water jet-related accidents. Improperly controlled high-pressure water jets can cause serious foot and leg injuries and have even contributed to fatalities.

On the other hand, using advanced hydrodemolition robots for this same tank cleaning task allows workers to remain at a safe distance and operate the unit via remote — even from outside the tank in some cases. While this increased area of operation does not eliminate the need for PPE, it allows workers to safely complete the cleaning without donning full body suits or breathing apparatus, saving time, resources and discomfort.

Compact units from OEMs offer further increases to job site safety by eliminating the need for workers to enter confined spaces

such as tanks and pipes. Some advanced models can easily be broken down into smaller components — a third of their original size that can enter these tight and inhospitable environments.

Advanced systems from OEMs can also reduce or even eliminate the need for scaffolding — another common safety risk for industrial cleaning specialists. Remote operation allows workers to stay safely on the ground and away from ledges or fall hazards and eliminating the need to erect scaffolding or fall protections increases overall productivity.

One type of innovative system features a lightweight, compact control unit and robotic power head with high-pressure lance that attaches to and robotically moves along standard scaffolding pipes. This setup is ideal for quickly covering large areas without requiring crews to work at height. Larger hydrodemolition robots are another option. These advanced units feature an innovative steel mast section with a reach of up to 23 feet that can eliminate the need for scaffolding all together. Additional mast sections can be employed to extend reach for larger projects, as well.

MAXIMUM PRODUCTIVITY

Increased worker safety is only part of the equation when it comes to overall equipment effectiveness. For industrial facilities, routine maintenance and cleaning is a necessary but costly undertaking. Minimizing the customers' downtime must be a top priority for successful industrial cleaning contractors.

Among automated options, robotic hydrodemolition equipment has proven to provide optimal efficiency, where applicable. Specialized equipment for applications such as tank, scrubber or heat exchanger shell cleaning are widely used across the industry, removing workers from some of the most dangerous and challenging jobs. But these still require support crews that vary in size. A hydrodemolition robot, on the other hand, can perform many of the same applications with a single operator. This allows contractors to better utilize crews and maximize productivity across the job site.

Operating at pressures up to 40,000 psi, hydrodemolition robots also provide more productivity compared to hand lances and other automated options. For example, when used on a routine scrubber application at a pulp and paper mill, one contractor was able to increase productivity 80%, completing a job that usually took 30 hours in just five.

For removing concrete, paint or other coatings, powerful hydrodemolition equipment again provides maximum productivity compared to hand lances, due to the robot's ability to handle the higher water flow rates and reaction forces necessary for successful material removal. At 40,000 psi, hand lances can only safely offer 5-6 gpm for reaction forces up to 62 pounds-thrust, whereas a compact hydrodemolition robot can easily handle 30 gpm for up to 312 pounds-thrust of reaction force. So while a hand lance might be used to remove refractory concrete, the process would be far more time and labor intensive with removal rates of just 0.5 to 1.0 cubic feet per hour. Compare that to a compact hydrodemolition robot, which can remove concrete at rates of 10 cubic feet per hour — almost 10 times faster.

The increased productivity offered by robotic hydrodemolition equipment means industrial cleaning specialists can optimize operations during scheduled downtime. Contractors are able to complete cleaning applications faster and with less labor, leaving them free to move on to the next job while the facilities can restart production more quickly.

SERVICE FLEXIBILITY

But what exactly is the next job? For many contractors, adding advanced hydrodemolition robots to their fleet not only increases productivity and safety for industrial cleaning applications, but

opens the door to increased service offerings and long-term company growth. The power and precision of these machines allows them to branch out from surface preparation to full concrete demolition, as well as concrete or steel tunnel rehabilitation and repair tasks, refractory removal and much more.

Thanks to a variety of attachments from innovative OEMs, contractors can tailor hydrodemolition equipment packages to fit the current — and future — needs of their operation. For example, a number of OEM attachments exist that allow for more efficient concrete or material removal in tunnels and pipes. In conjunction with the robotic equipment, these tools allow for consistent cleaning or material removal on uneven or oval-shaped passageways, making them ideal for applications such as penstock cleaning, dam work and sewer rehabilitation. Other attachments enable removal of concrete, paint, rust and coatings along an entire section of horizontal, vertical or inclined tunnels and pipes for applications such as removal of refractory concrete in risers and transfer lines.

In addition to attachments, hydrodemolition OEMs also provide support equipment that can increase efficiency for industrial cleaning applications as well as open up new revenue opportunities. A silent running high-pressure pump/engine combination was recently unveiled that provides the necessary pressure for industrial cleaning applications but is quiet and compact enough for any urban job site, allowing for growth into new markets, such as demolition, road and bridge repair and refractory removal. This system is available at up to 700 hp and features integrated auto start/stop technology that improves fuel consumption — saving as much as 6.6 gallons of fuel a day — while operating at up to 43,511 psi and under 65 dB.

INDUSTRIOUS PARTNERS

Capitalizing on industrial cleaning safety, productivity and growth potential starts with investing in the right tools. There are a number of specialized industrial cleaning mechanisms available that provide an automated solution to help limit worker exposure in the most hazardous conditions. But for forward-thinking contractors, these methods fall short when compared to the power, versatility and safety offered by compact hydrodemolition equipment. Working with reputable OEMs to customize hydrodemolition equipment packages that meet current and future business goals can help ensure longterm success. c

CONTRARY TO POPULAR BELIEF, HAVING ACCESS TO LARGE AMOUNTS OF MONEY ISN'T WHAT MAKES SOMEONE A DISRUPTOR.

If you're ready to lead your industry to new heights, here are the five keys that will help shift your mindset so you can be the disruptor others react to.

1. GET COMFORTABLE WITH CHANGE.

Disruption is all about change. Any company that survives longterm has changed over the years. Whether they added new products or services, catered to a different market, or totally reinvented themselves, they had the courage to morph in some way. Unfortunately, many people get stuck in the vision of what their company was in the past, rather than what it could be in the future. Being a disruptor means being resilient. To build your resilience, refrain from asking disempowering questions like "How am I going to do this?" A better question is "Why am I going to do this?" "Why" leads to "when," and then "when" becomes "how." With your "why" and "when" already mapped out, the "how" becomes much easier and you're more apt to take that first step. Along the way, you'll run into roadblocks and rejection. That's okay. Learn from any setbacks

During storms, eagles soar higher because they know the crosswinds will help them gain altitude. In other words, during challenges they rise. Those are the kind of people you want in your inner circle. Realize that the eagles in your life don't have to be your friends. They can be coaches or mentors you hire or only see in a professional capacity. Ultimately, their goal is to help you soar higher, not encourage you to back off when things get tough. When you rely on those people for support and advice, you can see problems in a new light and come up with solutions that will transform your world.

BE THE CHANGE

Regardless of your past successes or failures, you can initiate industry change. So why settle for always reacting to the disruptions? Have the courage to take action. Be the disruptor that leads your industry to new heights — and your company to even greater success. c







KEEPING UP ON NEW TOOLS AND TECHNOLOGY GIVES CLEANING CONTRACTOR THE ABILITY TO SERVE A DIVERSE CLIENTELE

s Ian Siewart and his brother, Stuart, began charting a course for their new company, ESP&P Industrial Services, a simple but effective business philosophy served as their North Star: A multilegged stool is much more stable than a stool with just one leg.

"The more kinds of work you can do, the better," Ian Stewart says of the company the brothers established in 2011 in Jonesborough in northeastern Tennessee, branching off from their father's plumbing and industrial cleaning business. "Disney World has more than just one kind of roller-coaster ride, right?"

As a result, on any given day, the company's work crews might be using a remote-controlled triple lance machine to scour bundles of tubes in a power plant heat exchanger, a hydroblasting unit to flush coal ash out of a process sewer line, a skid-steer to remove lime mud from a 1 milliongallon tank in a paper mill or a combination vacuum truck to clear a clogged culvert in a dam by a hydroelectric plant.

"Our work is never boring, that's for sure," Stewart says. Another central philosophy also shaped the company's growth and direction: Invest in cutting-edge technology that can be applied to more than just one market sector.







"If you have only one tool in the box, you're just not as useful to customers," Stewart explains. "We invest in different kinds of equipment that can play multiple roles in multiple markets."

As an example, Stewart cites the company's four vacuum trucks, made by GapVax, Super Products and Guzzler Mfg. (a subsidiary of Federal Signal Corp.).

"We can use a vac truck to clean everything from a sewer mainline to a chemical tank to a sludge lagoon," he says. "This hammer isn't made for just one kind of nail. We use some of them for hydroexcavation, too."

EASING DOWNTURNS

Furthermore, the ability to serve customers in different market sectors helps shield the company from cyclical downturns.

"They all may be somewhat interconnected, but each of those markets can sustain itself as well," Stewart says. "So if one sector of the market slows down, our employees are multifaceted and multitrained, so we can go work in another sector."

Industrial cleaning for the chemical, utility, papermaking and mining industries, to name a few, generates about 60% of the company's revenue. The balance is provided by hydroexcavation work; applying industrial coatings; and cleaning and inspecting sewer lines for a range of customers, including municipalities, bigbox retailers and apartment complexes.

The industrial coatings capability underscores the company's ability to react to customers' needs by providing services that complement its core services. The company started applying highperformance paints and chemical coatings in 2016.

The company already was doing a lot of cleaning and prep work on tanks, pipelines and so forth, but customers also needed those surfaces painted or chemically coated.

"So they asked us if we could just do the whole thing — be a onestop shop for them," Stewart says. "And that allowed us to branch into a lot of different avenues."

For painting and coating, ESP&P uses products made by Blome International, Sherwin Williams and Carboline. Most painting and coating is done by hand in a three- to five-step process, but the company uses a Graco King pneumatic airless sprayer for some applications.

BUILT-IN BRANDING

The company's name reflects that additional service; ESP&P stands for Essential Services, Pressure-washing and Painting. But it also plays off the acronym for the company founded by Stewart's father, Ed: ESP, which stands for Ed Stewart Plumbing, a business that also did smaller-scale industrial cleaning.

The brothers worked for their father for about 15 years before striking out on their own.

"We learned everything we know from him," Stewart says of his father, now retired at age 81. "But we wanted to expand and broaden the company's services, and he was happy doing what he was doing.

"You sort of reach a bubble point where you're not growing ... we wanted to expand into larger industries and into a larger service area. But he didn't want to deal with all the additional headaches that come with more employees, more overhead costs and so on."

The example set by their hardworking father left a lasting impression on the brothers.

"I'm not afraid to work and neither is my brother," Stewart says. "We're very proud of the work we do - we're very emotionally attached to our jobs.

"Our dad was a real hard-ass ... but he taught us a lot about striving to be the best because there's always someone new coming up behind you. He also showed us how important it is to be passionate about what you do for a living. I know it sounds kind of like a BS cliche, but it's true.

"If you get up every day and hate what you do, you're not going to provide a good service."


VALUABLE INVESTMENTS

To serve different markets requires investments in different kinds of equipment, such as the four vac trucks: one from GapVax, two made by Super Products and one built by Guzzler (a brand built by Vactor).

The GapVax unit features a 2020 Peterbilt tri-axle chassis with a 15-cubic-yard debris tank, a 1,200-gallon water tank and a 5,200 cfm Roots blower (a brand owned by the Howden Group). The Super Products trucks were built on 2017 and 2018 Freightliner chassis with 12-cubicyard carbon steel debris tanks, 1,000-gallon water tanks and 4,500 cfm Roots blowers.

"I don't like little blowers," Stewart says. "I try to overpower everything. We do a fair amount of work 500 feet from the truck, so we need that kind of power to pull material."

The Guzzler unit is built on a 2015 Kenworth chassis with a 15-cubic-yard carbon steel debris tank and a Roots blower (5,200 cfm).

The company also owns 13 trailer-mounted hydroblasting units. Four were built by Hammelmann Corp. Three of them feature water pumps that generate pressure of 40,000 psi and flow of up to 5.5 gpm and one that delivers 15,000 psi at 50 gpm.

"We use the three bigger hydroblasters for larger stripping and descaling jobs and the smaller one for descaling and tank cleaning," Stewart explains. "Sometimes you need to cut material but not move it while other times you need to cut material and move it.

"A butcher owns more than one knife. You can't use a paring knife for slaughtering."

ESP&P also owns four hydroblasters built by NLB Corp. (two that generate 20,000 psi at 30 gpm and two that produce 22,000 psi at 18 gpm); three from Jetstream of Houston (15,000 psi at 13 gpm); one manufactured by Aquadyne Industrial Pump Systems (10,000 psi at 40 gpm); and one made by Butterworth (10,000 psi at 40 gpm).

In addition, for long vacuum pulls of thick solids on job sites that are inaccessible for vacuum trucks, the company relies on Sludge Master plunger pumps built by Wastecorp Pumps.

For pipeline inspections, the company owns a push camera made by MyTana as well as a Proteus crawler camera system by Visual Imaging Resources and pole cameras built by Mini-Cam (a Halma company).

For excavation, ESP&P also owns a mini-excavator and several trackloaders made by Bobcat and a Freightliner dump truck with a 15-cubicyard dump bed made by Ox Bodies.

Furthermore, the company invested in a remote-controlled, triplelance tube-cleaning machine built by Peinemann Mobilift Groep B.V. The company also owns three hot-water pressure washers made by Alkota Cleaning Systems (4,500 psi at 6 gpm). C O N T | N U E D >>

an Stewart truly enjoys coming up with outside-the-box solutions that solve customers' problems. In fact, it's one of the things he likes most about running ESP&P Industrial Services, the Jonesborough, Tennessee-based business he co-owns with his brother, Stuart.

"Problem-solving is the most fun part of my job," Stewart says. "That's the real thrill — finding that next challenge we can take on and solve for our customers."

The company faced such a challenge about two years ago at a paper mill in Tennessee. The problem: A broken auger located at the base of a huge silo used to store wood dust from the papermaking process.

The silo was about 60 feet in diameter and roughly 60 feet tall. The auger — about the size of a dump truck — needed to be repaired, but the silo was about 75% full of wood dust, a byproduct of the papermaking process.

"We had to get inside it to clean it out because we couldn't do much from the outside," Stewart explains.

The only access to the silo's interior was via a roughly 24-inch-wide manway located about 30 feet up, which was surrounded by a larger maintenance door — think of it as a smaller door inside a larger door. But opening the larger door to provide enough room for entry would have put employees at risk if the debris inside collapsed as it was opened, he says. The only other alternative was cutting into the silo, which would've ruined the structure.

Stewart got to work on a solution. It started with building scaffolding up to the manway. Then employees pushed the material away from the manway with an NLB Corp. hydroblaster. At the same time, they used a Guzzler vacuum truck (built by Vactor) to remove the material.

"The wood dust was very compacted, so we had to use a hydroblaster to bust it loose," he says. "When that dust sits around like that, with all that weight on it, it likes to turn back into a tree.

"It was like hydroexcavating wood dust. We removed enough material to relieve any pressure on the larger maintenance door and eliminate the hazard of that material collapsing when we opened it.'

Next, employees built a long wooden ramp about 150 feet long and 60 feet wide up to the manway. Then an operator "drove" a remote-controlled Bobcat skid-steer up the ramp and through the maintenance door and began removing the wood dust. The skid-steer dropped its loads on the ramp, where workers shoveled it onto the ground for collection by skid loaders, Stewart says.

"That Bobcat allowed us to do the work safely, without any confined-space entry that would put employees at risk."

It took about four days of around-the-clock work to remove all the material.

"We had to get it done as quickly as possible," Stewart says. "Downtime costs customers money. So we did what we always do: develop solutions using a risk-versus-gain formula."

"You know how when moms tell their kids to clean their bedrooms and they throw everything under the bed? Well, a lot of companies have that mentality, instead of doing the right thing and leaving a job with a clear conscience. They get too big and everything becomes just a procedure and work suffers."

DRIVEN TO THRIVE

Countering that mentality requires hiring people who are just

as proud of the company as the owners, Stewart says. And while he admits he has no magic formula for figuring out which prospective employees have that intangible quality and which ones don't, he says the ones that do generally have one common denominator: They either have strong sports backgrounds or come out of the military.

"People who have that athletic drive also tend to have a good work attitude," he says. "Most of our guys played sports — they're in good physical shape, embrace challenges, are open to coaching and love to win.

"You can't hire people based just on that, but a sports background helps. It's much the same for ex-military people. They've already made it through big challenges and are self-disciplined."

That's not to say the company doesn't have good employees who never played sports or joined the military, Stewart notes. But those that thrive understand that hard work and long hours come with the territory.

"If you like a fixed schedule and want to know exactly when you're going to get off work every day, this job ain't for you," he says.

To help attract and retain quality employees, the company offers above-average salaries, pays performance bonuses and also quickly promotes high-performing workers. The company also will pay for specialized training classes and other educational opportunities for employees that are highly motivated and have a strong desire to learn more, Stewart says.

"Those kinds of employees - people who ask questions and want to take on more responsibilities without always asking for a pay raise — are like unicorns. So you need to feed that motivation and internal drive." C O N T | N U E D >>

GAME-CHANGING TECHNOLOGY

Part of the company's success stems from investing in equipment that boosts productivity, improves employee safety and provides customers with peace of mind. A good example is the triple-lancing machine from Peinemann, which Stewart says was a game-changing investment.

Because it can be controlled from a distance, the \$50,000 machine is significantly safer. This benefits employees while also qualifying ESP&P for projects at companies that demand top-tier safety records, he says.

Moreover, the machine reduced manpower needs on job sites from 12 to just two people. "So we can take all those other people and put them on different jobs, which increases revenue. Plus it gives customers peace of mind because they know we're a company that puts safety first.

"Any time you can invest in technology that removes people from hazardous situations, makes work easier on employees, increases efficiency and keeps customers happy, it's really worthwhile."

Stewart sums up a primary key to the company's success in two words: "We care."



Stewart also says his wife, Adrienne, the company's office manager, along with his brother, Stuart, and his wife, Sunnie, are key forces behind the company's success.

"Stuart works his ass off every day," he says. "Sunnie manages all of our coating jobs, government-project bids and department of transportation compliance.

"And Adrienne is the glue that keeps it all together. She stays remarkably calm under pressure, which is a magic ability. I would be lost without her."

FOOT ON THE GAS

There was a time when Stewart wasn't entirely amped about constantly growing bigger. But now he's overcome any concerns about that.

"It's like having kids," he says. "You might initially be hesitant, but after the third one, you're not afraid anymore."

As such, the brothers plan to keep pressing down on the gas pedal. Stewart believes that for successful companies, getting bigger is a necessity because it requires the company to keep its competitive edge sharp.

"We plan to keep building a skilled workforce and stay up to date on technology — keep moving with the times," he says. "We all might be going to work on hoverboards five or 10 years from now; who knows what's coming next in terms of technology?

"I sure don't. All I know is that five years from now, I'd like to have another conversation and talk about how we took things to the next level. If you don't have any kind of plan, you're not going anywhere at all." c



HEAVY HITTER

For clearing drainline clogs, this easy-to-carry water jetter punches above its weight // By Ken Wysocky

HEN BEN THOMAS BOUGHT a lightweight
Drain Invader water jetter from Jetters Northwest about a year ago, the general manager of 1-Hour Drain in San Jose, California, figured he'd buy more if it worked as advertised.

It did — and Thomas now plans to eventually put a Drain Invader in each of the company's 12 service vehicles, a mix of Nissan NV 2500s and Ford and Chevrolet vans.

"Initially, I thought it would work really well for the kind of work we do, which is primarily unclogging smaller drainlines in homes $\frac{1}{2}$

and apartment complexes," Thomas says. Owner Robert Gallaher established the company in 2011; it employs 22 people, including 16 technicians.

"Having a portable jetter that you can hand-carry into someone's apartment or house has been really a game-changer for our guys," Thomas says. "It's so easy to bring it in and out of places."

Moreover, the 18-pound unit (28 pounds when used with the two-wheeled detachable cart that comes with it) is small enough to hang on the wall of a service vehicle. That way it doesn't occupy valuable floor space in already cramped cargo areas. (An optional wall-mount unit is also available.)

Technician Francisco Escoto of 1-Hour Drain in San Jose, California, uses a Drain Invader from Jetters Northwest to clean out a 1 1/2-inch-diameter bathroom sink drainline.

While the Drain Invader may be light, it doesn't lack power. Thomas says he recently encountered a bad stoppage in a 2-inch-diameter kitchen drainline in an apartment complex. The clog was between a clean-out and a mainline and snaking it wasn't getting the job done.

"We couldn't get through the clog with our snake, so we put the jetter in there with a 'knucklehead' nozzle," he says. "And in about 15 minutes or less, we cleared the clog, which was mostly grease and food debris."

BETTER EFFICIENCY

It's not that Thomas doesn't have other jetters and drain machines at his disposal. 1-Hour Drain has invested in two trailer jetters from Jetters Northwest, as well as a Brute cart jetter, and drum cable machines built by RIDGID and Milwaukee Tool.

But accessibility is frequently an issue with large machines.

A trailer jetter doesn't always work if an apartment is, say, 500 feet away from the nearest parking lot. And that's where the Drain Invader's portability pays big dividends, Thomas says.

"About 70% of the stoppages we run across are drain clogs in multifamily units. As a result, we have a lot of back-to-back jobs because the units are stacked on top of each other and more than one is affected by the clog.

"The Drain Invaders allow us to get into those units quickly and efficiently, without the setup time required to run our trailer jetters. We can run a 3/16-inch-diameter hose through the line that's very flexible and easy to get into the pipe.

"In addition, a jetter will clear a clog, as opposed to just punching a hole in it," he adds. "Even if we use cable machines to clear a stoppage, we'll also jet it, just to be sure."

AMPED UP

The electric-powered Drain Invader is designed to clear indoor drains up to 3 inches in diameter. It comes with a 25-foot power cord with a two-prong plug and can run off a standard, 15-amp, 110-volt electrical outlet.

The machine produces pressure of 2,050 psi at 1.4 gpm and comes with three nozzles — one for flushing, one for penetrating clogs, and a knucklehead trap nozzle to better navigate P-traps and other tight bends.

Hose options include a 1/8-inch-diameter, 50-foot-long poly hose from Piranha Hose Products or a 3/16-inch-diameter, braided stainless steel hose available in 25-, 50-, 75- or 100-foot lengths.

The Drain Invader also features an auto-stop and auto-start function aimed at enhancing motor longevity because it only runs during actual jetting. "That's a really nice feature," Thomas says.

The machine is also very easy to operate. "We show our guys once how to use it and they're good to go. If you can operate a pressure washer with a wand on it, you can easily operate this machine."

REVENUE GENERATOR

So how does the Drain Invader help Thomas increase revenue? Better productivity. Taking less time to unclog lines means technicians can clean more lines per week, which boosts revenue and profitability, Thomas says.


Furthermore, profit-killing callbacks diminish significantly when employees use a jetter. Thomas says he even offers a 30-day warranty for lines the company jets (except under extenuating circumstances).

"Plus, if we provide faster and better service, customers will give us word-of-mouth referrals or call us back the next time they need service. And if we throw in a courtesy jetting after we use a cable machine, it makes customers feel good."

At a base price of \$795, Thomas says the Drain Invader provides a great return on investment. It also fits in well with his business philosophy about continually investing in new technology — the more arrows in the quiver to handle various situations, the better.

"We try to stay on top of the best products out there that can help our guys be as efficient as possible and not break their backs," he says. "At this price point, why wouldn't I have one on each truck?

"I highly recommend this machine. For the price, it's a mistake to not have one of these in your van." c







MEETING DEMAND

Petersen Products takes on pipe lining challenges and creates the products to solve them // By Kim Peterson

T'S NOT EVERY COMPANY that provides tools, accessories and fittings to industries ranging from plumbing to aerospace engineering. But Petersen Products Co. has been providing products and solutions for the plumbing and pipe lining industries for decades, as well as working on engineering solutions for NASA and a wide range of other industries.

The founder's first patent was issued in 1916, and since then, the company has continuously improved its skill and capacity to provide a steady flow of new product and service solutions for its customers.

Cleaner recently spoke with Tom Muldoon, president of Petersen Products, about the company's products and their applications, customizing solutions for customers, and what's to come in the pipe lining industry.

CLEANER: Tell us a little about the history of Petersen Products.

Muldoon: Petersen Products is a generational family business started over 100 years ago. The Drain Flusher was its founding product and while the business has entered and exited several industries since, it has developed a deep knowledge base in engineering solutions for the pipe lining and plumbing industries.

CLEANER: What differentiates your pipe lining products from the competition?

Muldoon: Petersen Products holds a unique market position as the company that fulfills customers' most demanding product and service requirements. We support product excellence with world-class customer care, quick delivery and complete solutions. Our solutions include industry firsts such as the High Pressure Inflatable Flow Stop, and midmarket plugging solutions, like the Multi-Flex inflatable plugs and a range of low-to-high pressure mechanical plugs.

Our patented and founding product lines, the Drain Flushers and Sewer Cleaning Tools, have stood the test of time. Not only has

Petersen been manufacturing them since 1916, but each flusher is highly durable and long lasting.

CLEANER: What sort of needs do they address? Tell us about the plugs, packers, and flushers and what applications they best serve.

Muldoon: Our products were developed in response to customer demand over the years. We offer pipe plugs and packers for most size, pressure, chemical and temperature requirements. The Multi-Flex inflatable plugs work very well in high expansion applications: they are made from flexible, highly durable industrial material and have a small-deflated diameter so that they can navigate small openings. They conform to most pipe shapes and take up little storage space.

Petersen's mechanical high-pressure test plugs are often applied to force and water mains, lift stations, nuclear cooling lines, fire protection lines and many other projects where isolation is required for testing and construction. These plugs may be manufactured for almost any pressure and for rectangular or other shaped openings. These plugs offer easy installation, replaceable seals, and positive seal, and are engineered to restrain rated pipeline pressure.

Our Multi-Flex Point & Sectional Repair Inflatable Packers are often used in air, water and steam lining applications. Customers like the light weight compared to molded rubber styles and the quick insertion possibilities with the product's small-deflated diameter and high flexibility. CLEANER: What are some recommendations for customers shopping for pipe lining products?

Muldoon: For customers shopping pipe lining products, our Multi-Flex Repair Inflatable Packers are definitely worth looking at. They can be manufactured to most size, chemical and temperature requirements, and configurations can be provided for most relining requirements.





PUSH CAMERA AND ROLLER SKID SAVES TIME AND MONEY




PROBLEM / By the time a plumber showed up at a home in Valatie, New York, the customer was excited and stressed because the sewer pipe was backing up. No amount of plunging by the customer had worked and professional help was needed. An access plug in the pipe leading to the septic tank was easily accessible. Once removed, several buckets were used to collect sewage.

SOLUTION / The plumber installed the CPI Products Trapmaster to get a 1.5-inch push camera into the 4-inch pipe and was able to pass by the remaining debris to view the blockage and determine exactly where it was. It turned out to be the last remaining section of a more than 30-year-old asphalt-coated paper pipe that had collapsed. They were able to pinpoint this by using the push camera with the roller skid.

LINING SYSTEM USED TO FIX ROOT-INFESTED SEWER PIPE



PROBLEM / Mr. Rooter of Western Washington was called to help fix a root-infested sewer pipe on a nearly 100-year-old, two-family home in Seattle. The root infestation caused breaks in the lateral pipe and sewer backups in the basement. The multidiameter lateral, consisting of 4-inch cast iron for the first one-third of the pipe and 6-inch clay for the remainder, was approximately 85 feet from the basement clean-out to the city sewer main.

SOLUTION / A tailored, 4- to 6-inch polyester Transition Scrim Liner from Paramount Pipe Lining Products was used because it creates a smooth, seamless transition in pipes with multiple diameters. The five-step process involved removing roots from the pipe, mixing the epoxy, wetting out the liner, using air pressure to insert the liner into the pipe, and using a hot-water curing process. The liner was cured in less than two hours using the Hornet hot-water curing system.

RESULT / The entire sewer line from the basement out to the city sewer was effectively relined, forming a watertight barrier impenetrable by root intrusions. In less than two hours, the cracked and defective pipes were like new and 100% flow capacity was restored. 


